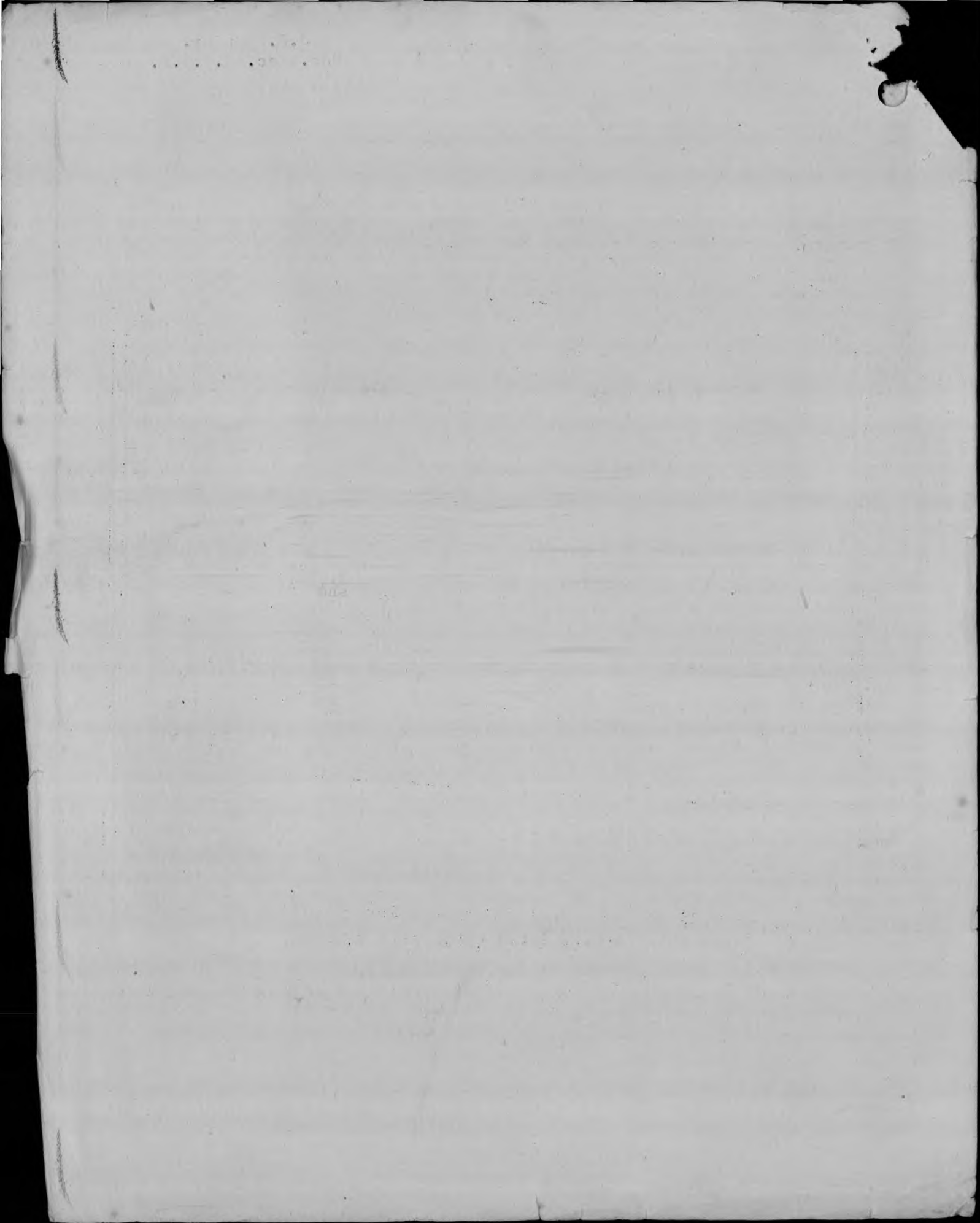

GAMES FOR ADJUDICATION.

Will all match captains please note that all positions for adjudication must reach the HON. ADJUDICATION SECRETARY (not Mr. Champ), Mr. T. VAUGHAN WILLIAMS, "THE PRIORY", PILLERTON PRIORS, WARWICK-SHIRE, within 7 days of the match being played. Positions must be sent in with claims by BOTH SIDES concerned. I am repeating this because the notice last month may have been misleading owing to the wording, and I am anxious to dispel any doubts as to what the correct adjudication procedure is.

COUNTY DELEGATES TO FIXTURE'S MEETING.

Mr. Lauder requests all Secretaries to ask their delegates to bring to the Fixture's Meeting on Saturday, Jan. 17th any ideas they may have on the following items so that the business in hand can be dealt with more expeditiously than heretofore:-

- (a) Venue for the 1960 B.C.F. Congress.
Any county in the Union is open to offer a venue for this congress and suggestions submitted to the Meeting will be passed on to the Federation.
- (b) B.C.F. School Shields.

It is open to any county to submit the name of a school deserving of consideration within its area, but any such suggestion should be supported by a citation presenting a very strong case for such an award.

(c) Inter-Union Matches.

The B.C.F. are asking for views of the Union on Inter-Union Matches. It is desirable that the views of the individual counties on this matter should be known as to the nature of the competition to be set up, and delegates to the Fixtures' Meeting are asked to have their county's ideas clearly in their minds.

(d) B.C.F. Development Committee.

Ideas from the counties are asked for to guide members serving on this Committee. These will be passed on to the proper quarter.

(e) Comments and suggestions on the B.B.C. Network Three Chess Programme.

(f) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE VACANCY.

It is desirable that this vacancy on the Union Executive should be filled without delay.

(g) S.C.C.U. vacancy on the London League sub-committee for Grading.

An offer for filling this will be welcomed. Come with suggestions.

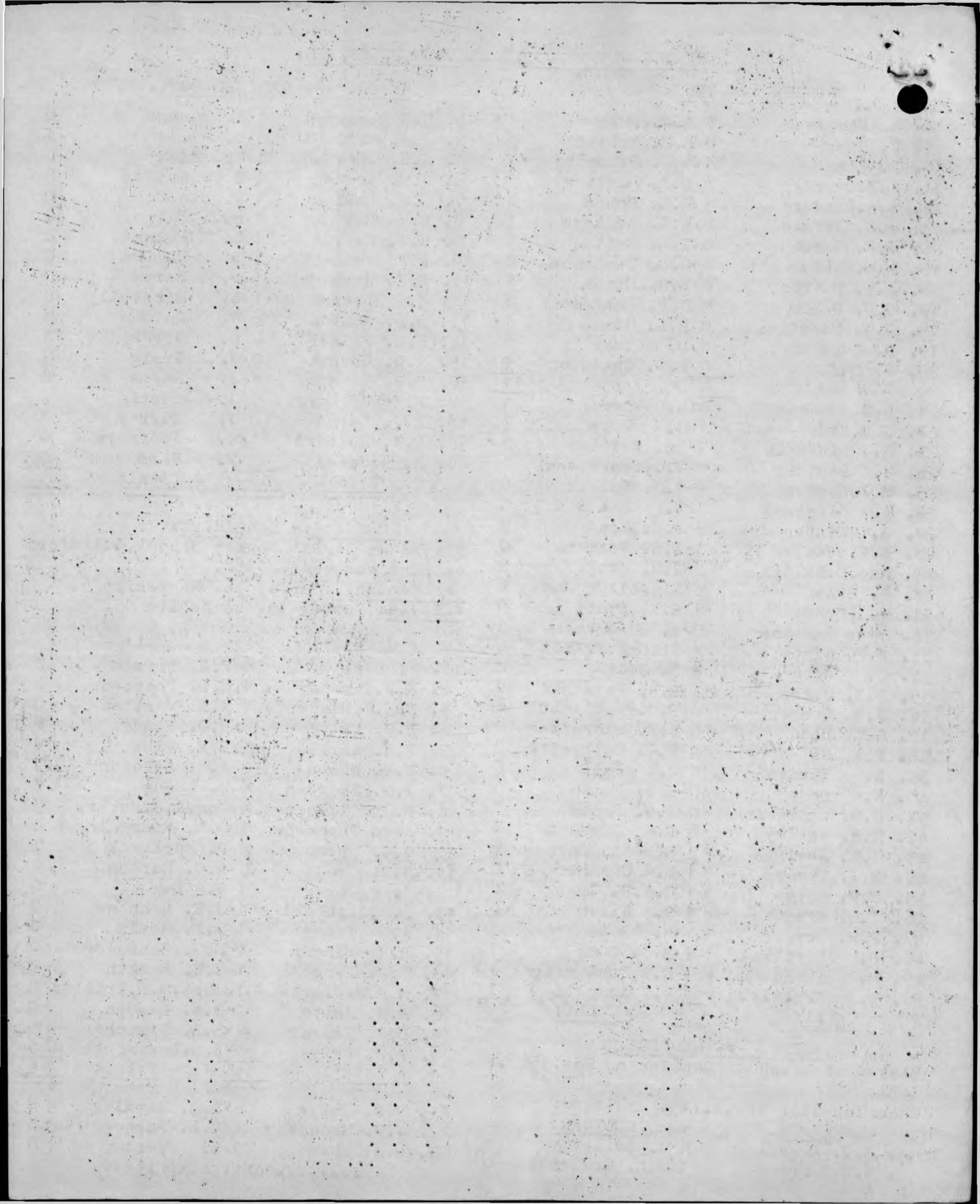

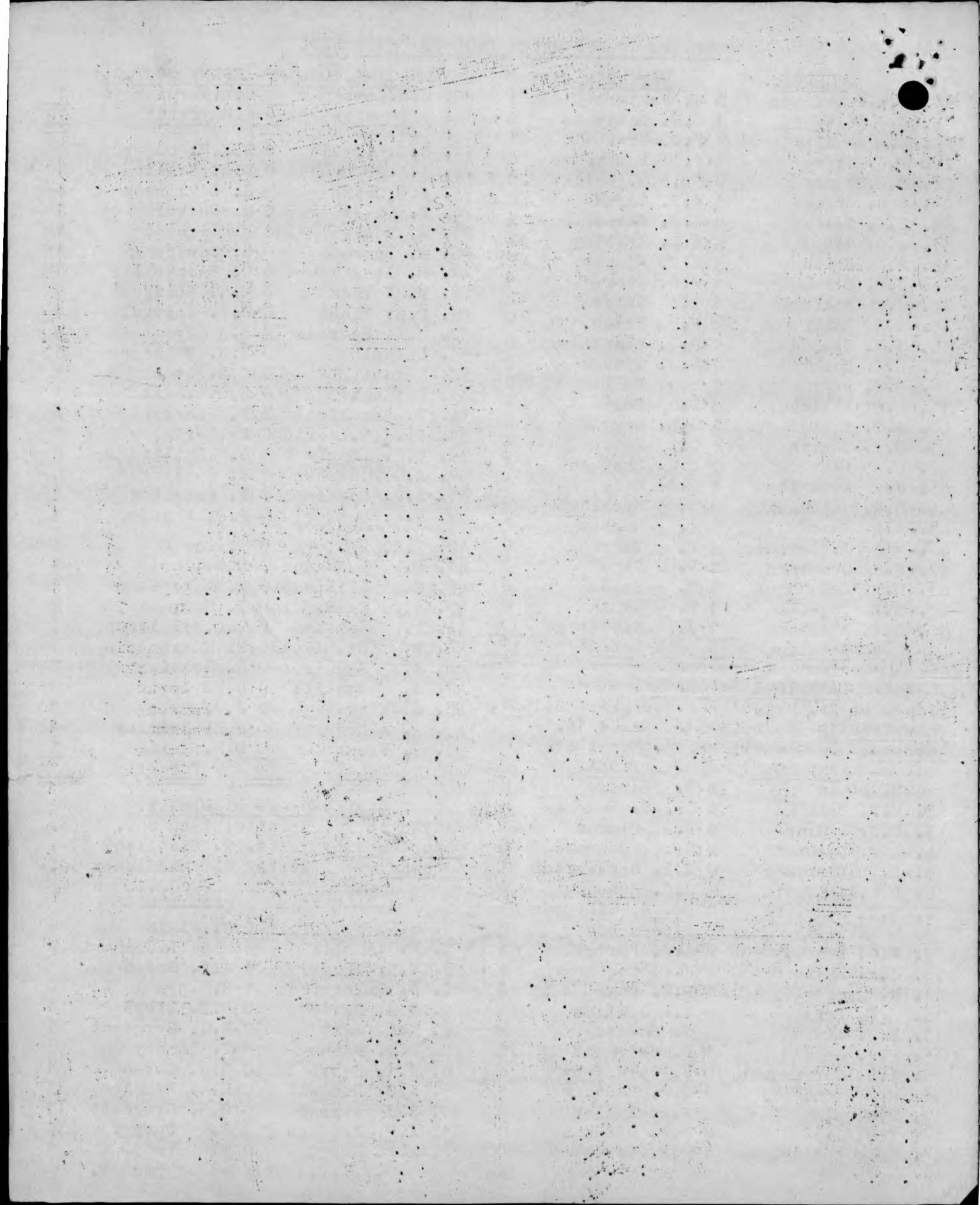
