

NEWS ITEMS.

Mr. K. Woodland, the Hertfordshire Junior County organiser, has written in to say that the Hertfordshire Chess Association has just held its second Christmas Congress in Barnet for boys from Junior Schoolls (boys under the age of 11). 53 boys from 11 schools took part in an eleven round Swiss Tournament lasting for four mornings forming the major item in a varied programme. An entry fee of 1/- per head brought in the major share of the cost of 10 book prizes. The Herts. Junior Organisers believe that the method they are adopting offers the only real prospect of developing the game among the very young and at Easter a congress of a similar nature is planned for the Hatfielld schools.


