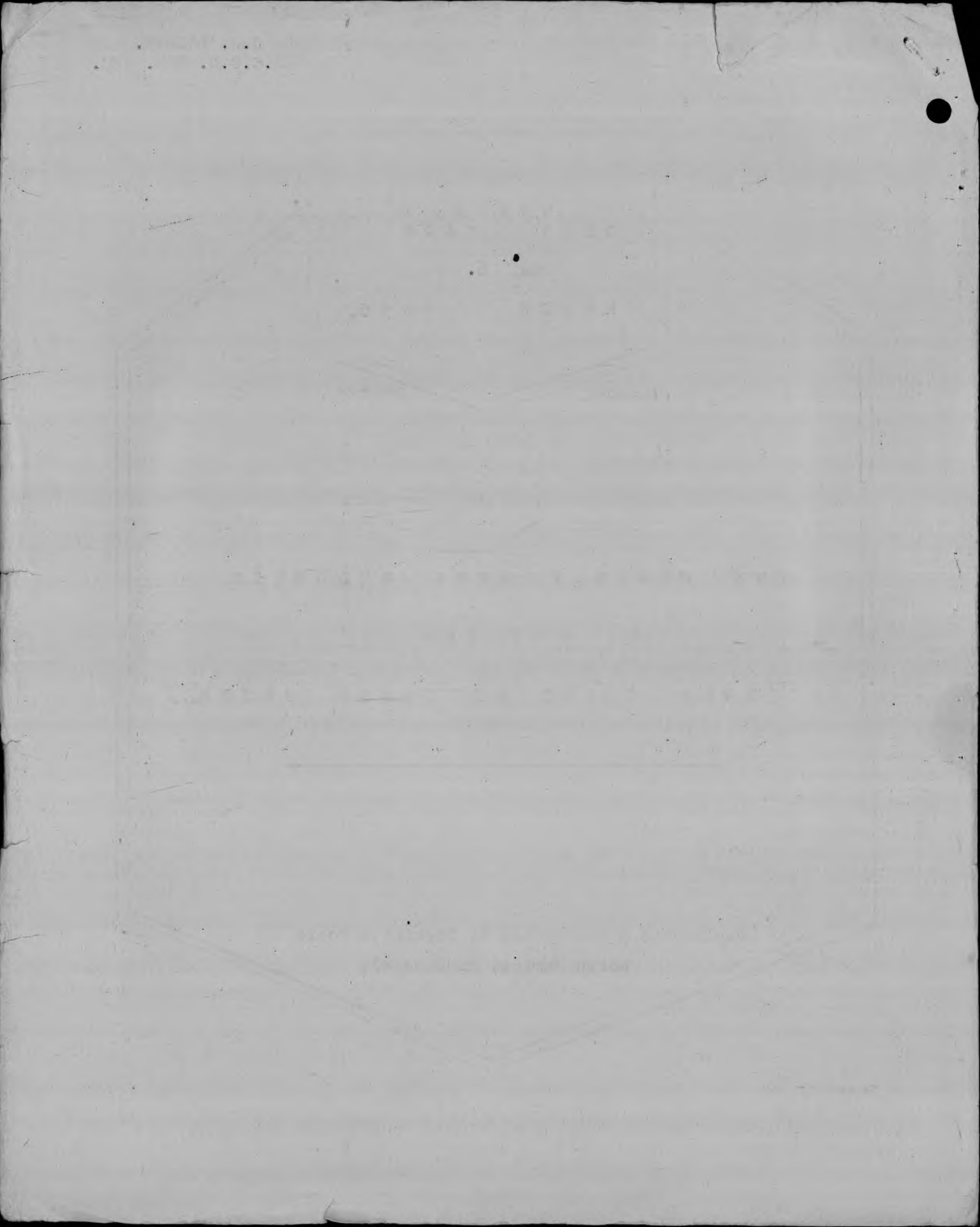

NEWS ITEMS.

BOGNOR: Mr. Lomax reports that the number of entries received to date have exceeded the 234 received last year. This is very gratifying to him indeed and to those who give of their best to make Bognor a S.C.C.U. highlight in the Chess Calendar.

B.C.F. CONGRESS 1960. The British Chess Federation have accepted the offer of the Leicestershire Chess Club for their 1960 August Chess Congress to be held at LEICESTER on the occasion of the Leicester Chess Club's Centenary.

The S.C.C.U. UNDER-18 INTER COUNTIES FINAL: Seven counties took part in this Junior event held at Stratford Church Institute on Saturday, 14th March, and Middlesex proceeded to the Under-18 National Inter-Counties Final as the S.C.C.U.'s representative. The Counties representing the other Unions are Devon, Glamorgan, Warwickshire and Yorkshire. Details of both these Junior Finals are found in the Junior news later on in this Bulletin.

CONGRESS GAMES: I would like to publish in the May issue an outstanding game played in each of the Easter Congress events not forgetting the Junior Sections. I hope Congress organisers will co-operate in this matter to make the last Bulletin of the season a worthwhile number to keep in your chess library.

CAMBRIDGE JUNIOR ORGANISER: Mr. H.W. Scarlett, 50 Fallowfield, Cambridge (Tel. Cambridge 58534) has taken over the job at least temporarily as the Cambridge Junior Organiser. Please note this in your diaries for reference.

A NEW JUNIOR CHESS VENUE: Durning Hall, Earlam Grove, Woodgrange Road, Forest Gate, E.7. belonging to a Charity Trust Organisation has consented to its premises being used as a Chess Centre for Junior events next season. It is the new home of the West Ham Chess Club and only some two minutes' walk from Forest Gate Station.
