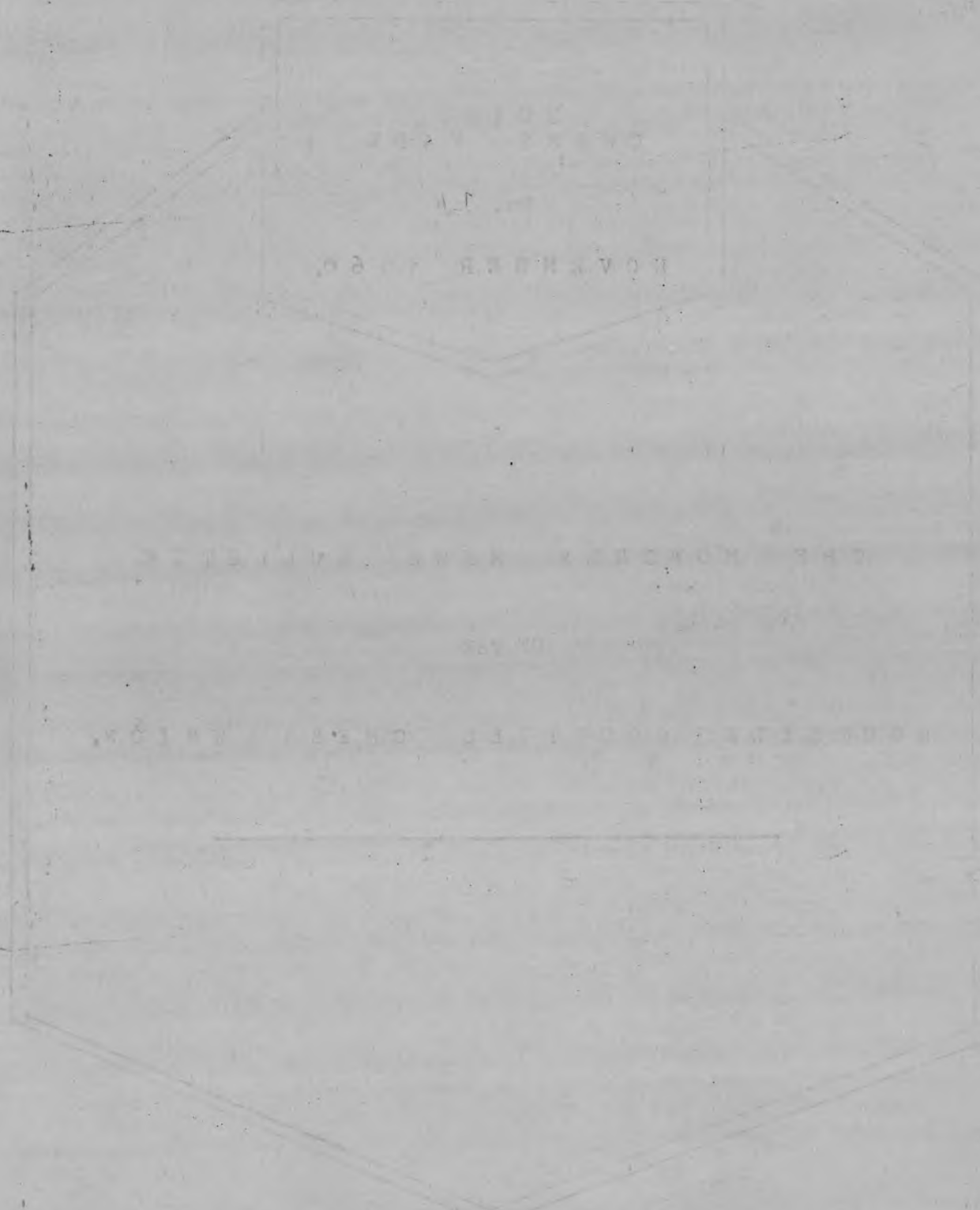

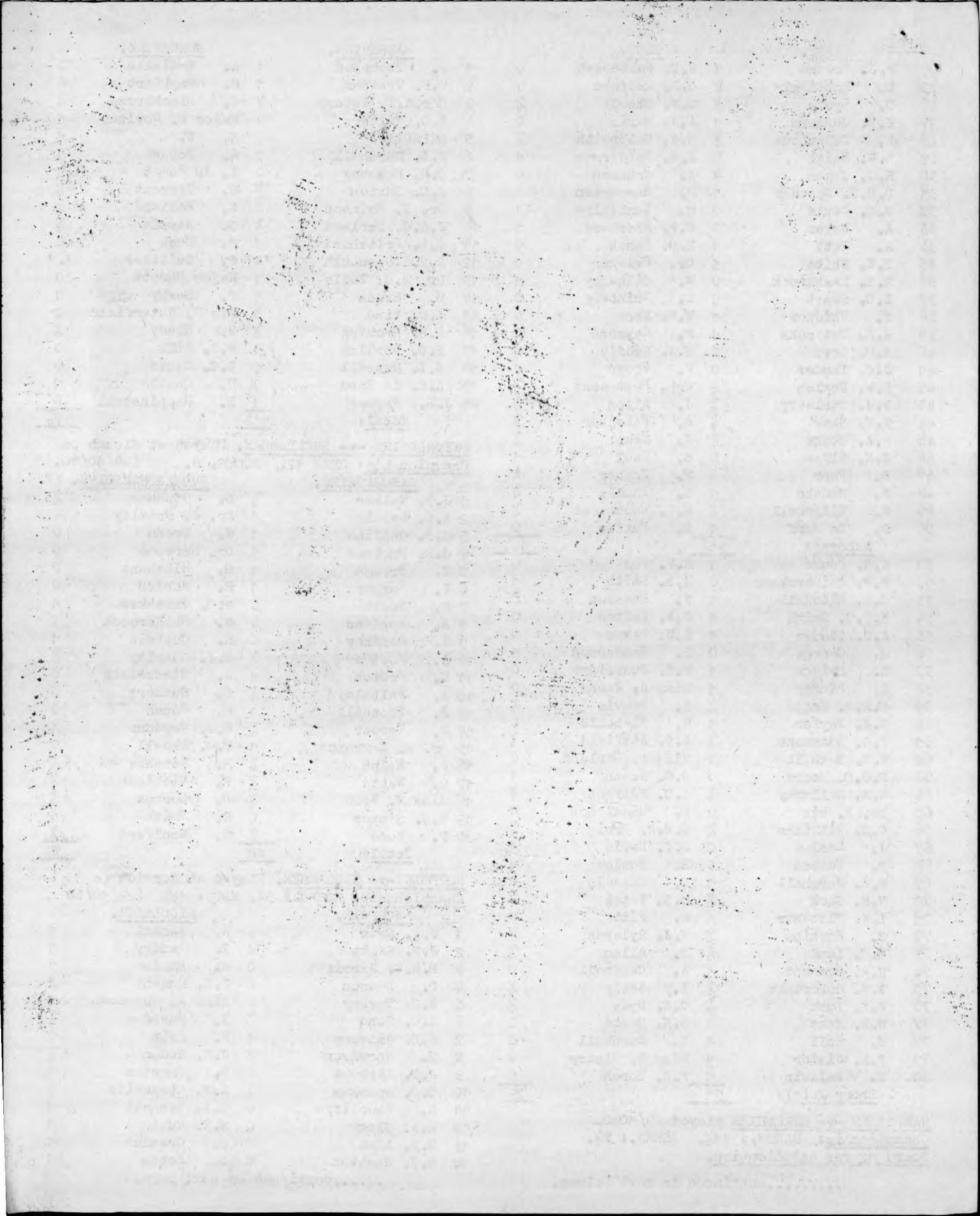

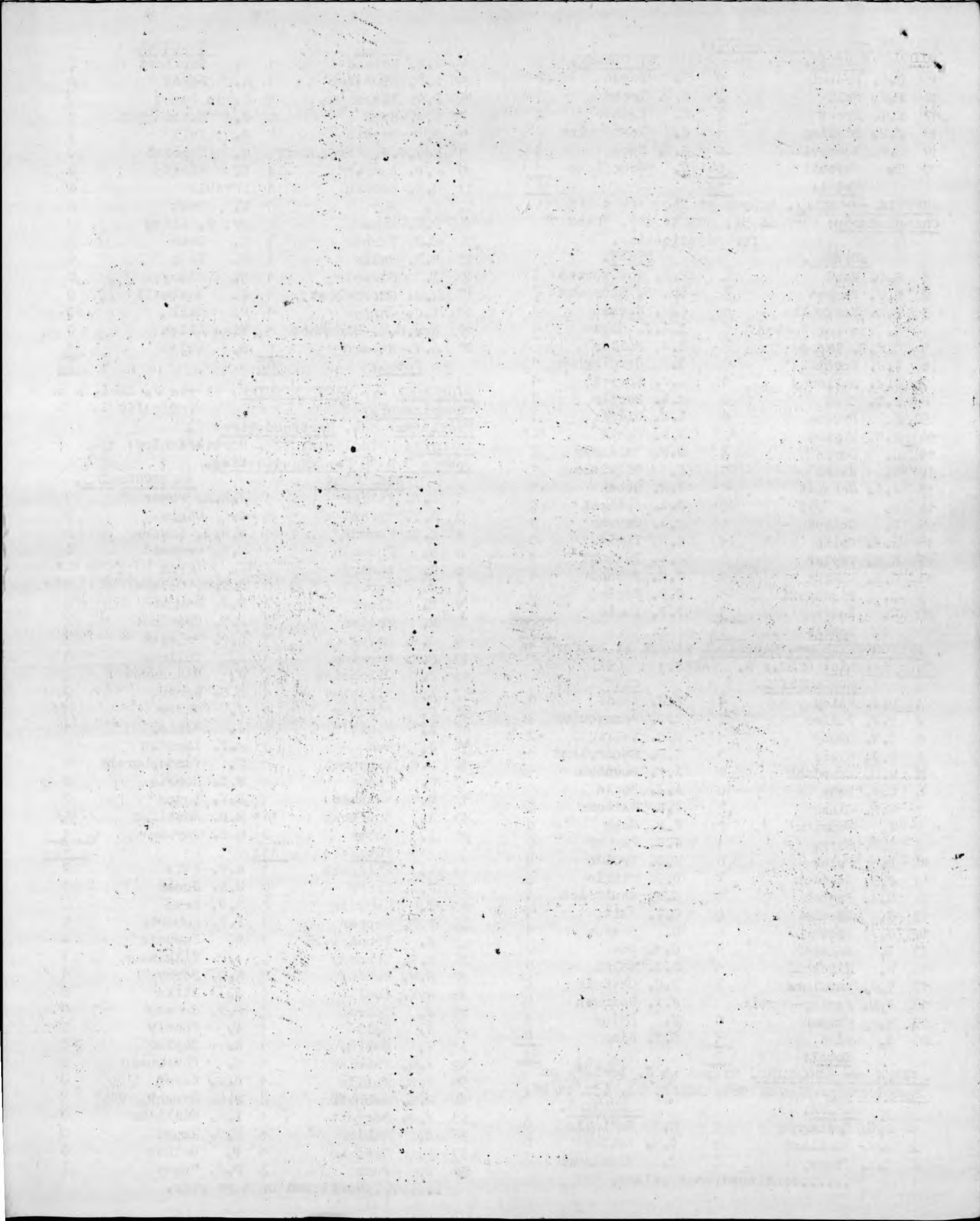

Ford, Aveley Junior School, Stifford Road, Aveley. Tel: Purflleet 5368. This trophy will be returned to the Secretary of the Essex County Chess Association for engraving and presentation and should the League become non-existent the trophy will be returned to the Association. This young league of players is in fine fettle and should provide some useful material for the County Team in the years to come. It has been reported that a Primary Schools Christmas Congress is contemplated and enquiries concerning this should be made to the secretary, Mr. Ford.
