### JUNIOR NEWS.

No more Junior county matches are scheduled for this year other than those already reported but two items of news are worth reporting if only to let the younger chess players know they are far from forgotten:

Mr. A. Moppett of the Hayes Harlington Club reports that 3 Hayes Juniors are making their mark in the Hayes district among senior players. These three, Richard Collins of Hayes Gr. Sch., Peter Adams of Townfield Sch., Brian Gillman of Our Lady & St. Anselm Sch., all play regularly for the senior Hayes Club and are more than holding their own in Middlesex Club matches. Their positions in the forthcoming London Junior Championships will be noted with great interest.

LONDON JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: 279 competitors ranging in age from 8 to 18 will be taking part in this annual event staged this year at St. Bride's Institute from December 28th to January 7th. An analysis of the geographical areas from which these competitors come shows that Middlesex is responsible for 108 of them, Surrey for 85, Kent for 30, Essex for 20 and Hertfordshire for 16. Needless to say visitors are welcomed and if any of you can give a helping hand please do give the Editor of this Bulletin particulars of dates when you can come and the capacity in which you would like to help. It's work well worth while.
