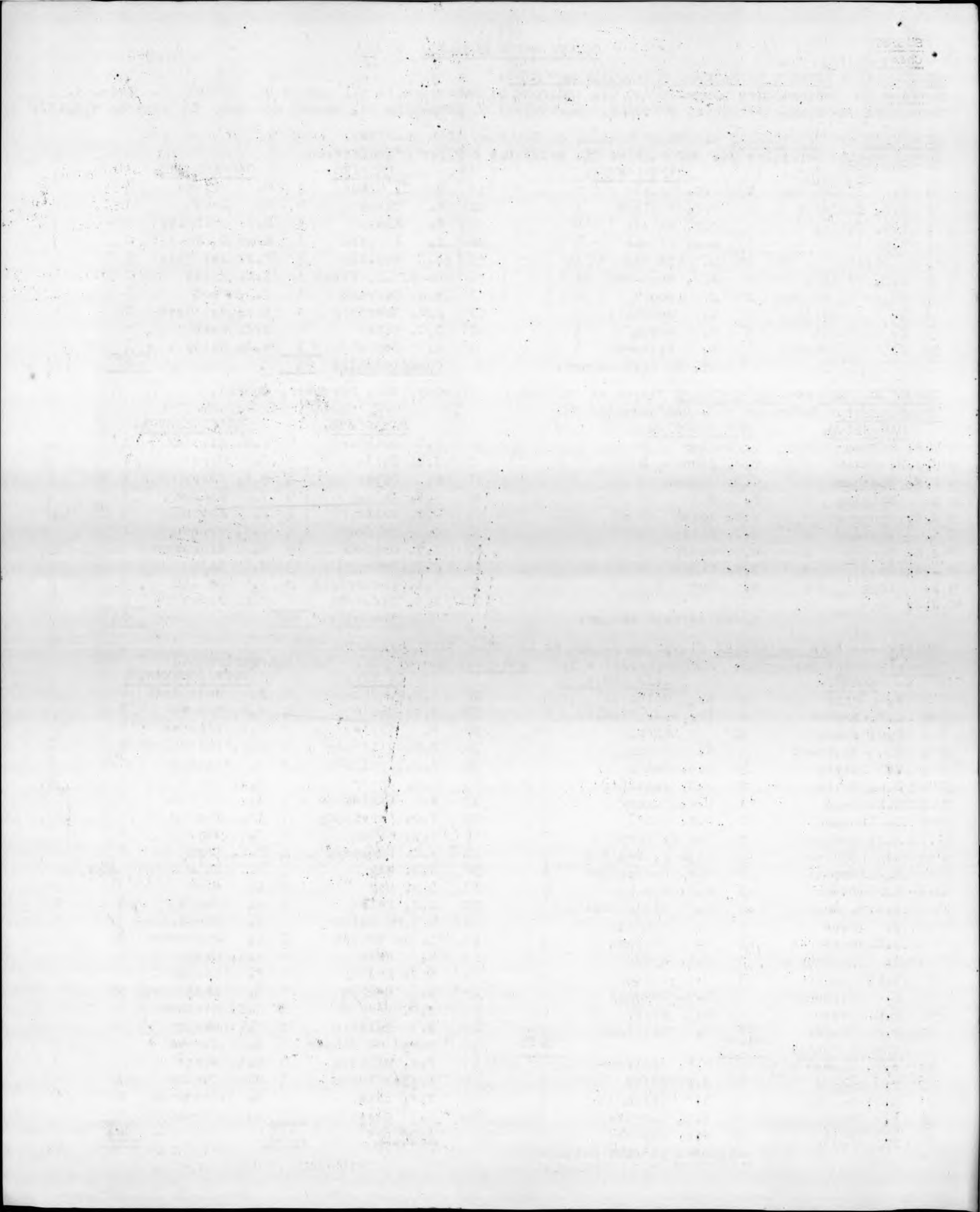

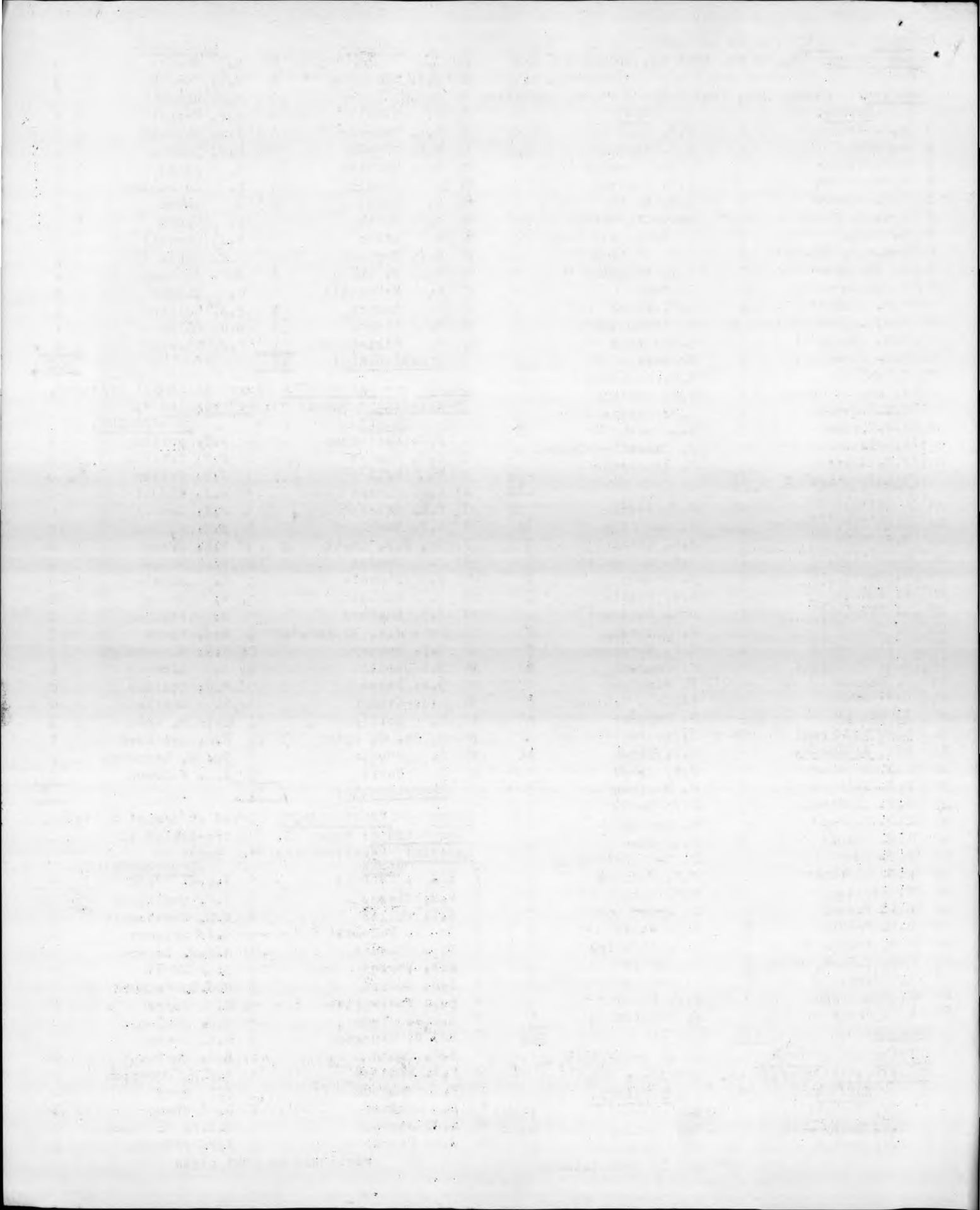

The S.C.C.U.'s second annual jamboree was held at John Lewis' Store, Oxford St., London on Saturday, 17th November, 1962 with 18 teams competing and as the responsible organiser I wish through the December issue of 'Chess Fare' to record my thanks to all concerned. Clarke on their recent marriage and also to Dr. J. Penrose and Miss M. Wood on their engagement.

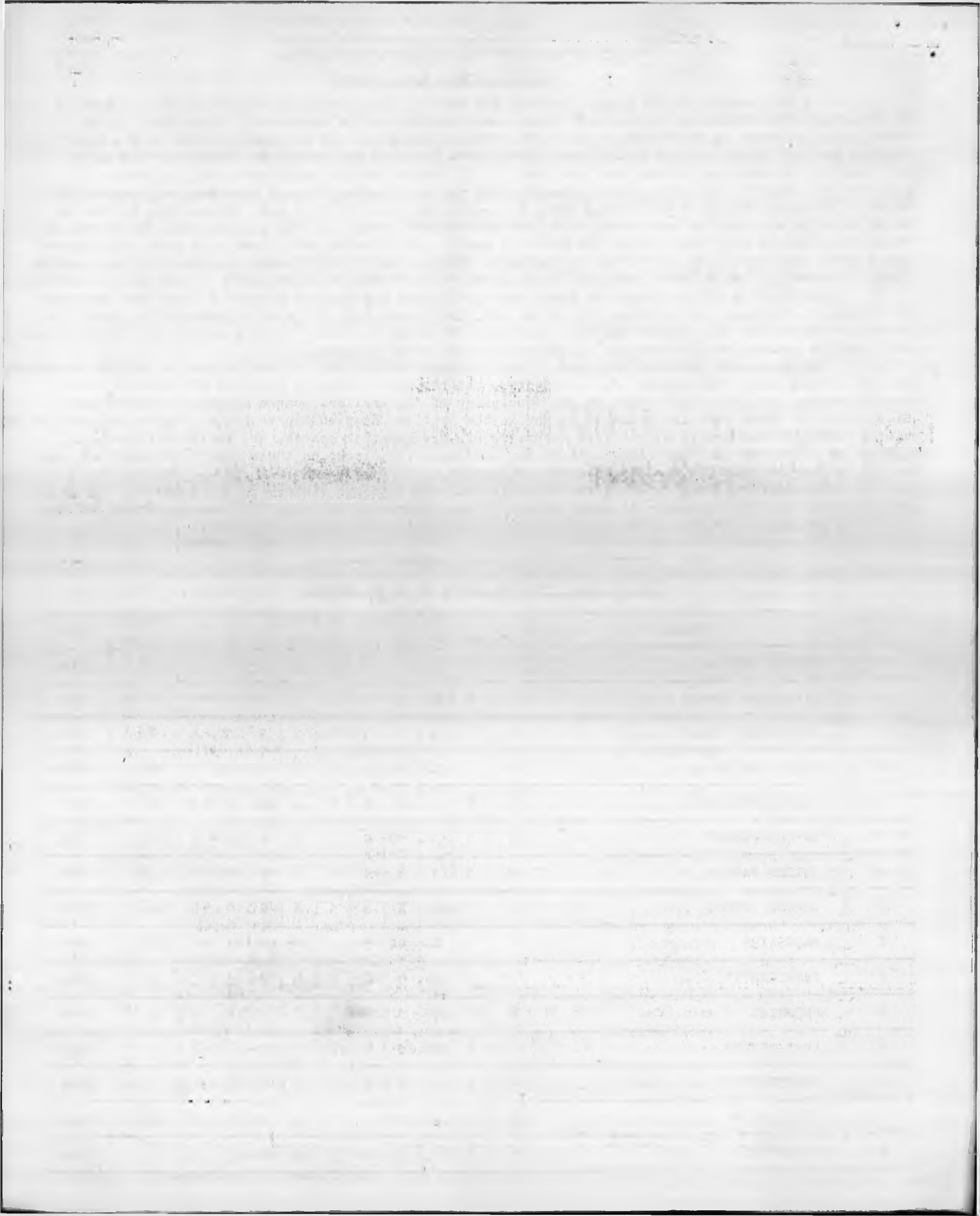

## 30 SELECTED UNDER-21 JUNIORS.

When I was asked by the British Soviet Friendship Society to select a team of Under-21 Juniors to engage Grandmaster Paul Keres on his first 1962 Simultaneous exhibition tour of Britain I accepted without demur. The difficulty was the selection. There were so many candidates to fill too few places. I intended to include players of merit between the 15- 21 age groups from all the S.C.C.U. counties and not merely from the London area, hoping those who accepted could reach the venue in time if they were not staying in London for the week-end. Needless to say there was not one refusal though the Cambridge contingent were dubious about the train service being on time and they were right. It delayed them though not unduly.

The result was that on Sunday morning of November 25th there faced the grandmaster as determined a crowd of British youth as he could ever hope to meet, eager to show him that if there was a 65th square on the eight by eight chess board they were out to find it, even at St. Pancras Town Hall. I, personally, though perhaps the only one present with the view, was quite sure he would not get 50% won games. The result vindicated my personal opinion. He won 14, drew 6, and lost 10. When it is realised that out of 231 games he played during his tour his total losses only came to 27 the S.C.C.U. Juniors can be proud indeed of their record and surely are to be congratulated on a result that shows the progress made through the intensive work put into Junior Chess during the last decade.
