EDITORIAL

I am sorry the production of this number has been delayed. News from various sources has been coming in rather later than usual, but now has reached a stage when I can edit what may be described as a "double number".

My thanks are due to our Junior Chess Organiser, P B Morrish for the full details of the London Junior Championships which appear in this number. Our County Junior organisers do a wonderful job for the young players, not only on the occasion of the London Championships but also for the Sunday Times competition, the Metropolitan and the S C C U Jamborees and the various Championships. The outstanding performance in this year's championships was that of Terry Fox of Kingston, who won the Senior Under Eighteen Championship, convincingly having previously won the Under Fourteen title in 1963, the Under Sixteen title in 1964 and now the Under Eighteen title, and he is still only just over fifteen years old.

At the Fortieth Hastings Annual Chess Congress, many players from clubs in the Southern Counties took part, and many appeared in the prize list. However, pride of place must go to O N Hindle who played in the Premier Tournament, finished with $4\frac{1}{2}$ points from nine games, beat Grand Master S Gligoric of Yugoslavia, drew with F Gheorghiu of Roumania, present Junior World Champion and failed only by half a point to get his first step towards an International Master title. It will come! The other Southern Counties representative, P N Lee (who has played this season for both Oxford and Middlesex!) scored two points. In the Challengers' Tournament we had five representatives and A S Hollis of Oxford finished equal third, Dr S Fazekas of Essex was sixth, J Basman of Surrey and W R Hartston of Middlesex were equal seventh and A P Sombor of Surrey was ninth.

Will County Match Captains please let Mr J T Pascoe, of 98 Wanstead Park Road, Ilford Essex (Tel: VALEntine 7394) have a list of players recommended for the match between the Union and the West of England, so that he can choose his team for this title match, which takes place sometime in May.
