EDITORIAL

Well, the season is drawing to a close - so far as the inter-county games within the Union are concerned. There are still a few results missing; particularly in the Northern Section, although I believe that Middlesex has won that half of the tournament - so far as the Championship is concerned, but I have not yet seen ^{the second} any of their Amboyna Shield results. In the Southern Section, Surrey has won the Championship and the Amboyna Shield competition, but having lost two matches in the Ebony Shield are out of that competition. In the County Championship quarter-finals, Middlesex are due to play Leicestershire and Surrey to play the county which finishes second in the Northern Counties competition. At the time of going to press, Surrey's opponents are not known. We can, however, congratulate our two representatives in the quarter finals, and wish them every success, so that they meet (as they can) in the final. For these two Counties, the season is by no means over!

I am sorry to say that I was misinformed about the final score of the Kent v Surrey match. The final Championship result was Kent 11, Surrey 9, board 18 should have been recorded as a draw between K Champlin (Kent) and D LeSurf (Surrey). Also on board 30 the correct score was A E Shepherd (Kent) 0 v S C Love (Surrey) 1. Will graders please note these amendments. My apologies, particularly to Mrs. Joyce Pentecost, Kent's match captain, who has worked so hard this season to improve her county's results. And a very good job indeed, she has made of it. It seems to me that both Mrs. Pentecost and Miss Eileen Tranmer, match captain of Middlesex are able to whip up far more enthusiasm amongst the County players than many mere male match captains elsewhere'. Congratulations to them both!

Don't forget that if you can get away for Easter, there are Congresses at Folkestone, Richmond and Southend on Sea for the Friday to Monday, and after Easter there is the Bognor Regis Congress from the Wednesday after Easter. You have already had details. I take this opportunity of enclosing details of the Marlow Congress taking place over the August Bank Holiday.

The result of the contest was a win for Middlesex with 10½ points, and this team, which is almost identical to that which came second last year, goes forward to the All-England Final on April 10th - with the good wishes of the S C C U for a win this time! Second was Surrey, 9½ points; 3rd Kent, 7½ points; 4th Essex, 7 points; 5th Hampshire, 5 points; 6th Berkshire, and Sussex with 4 points; 8th Oxfordshire, 3½ points and 9th Hertfordshire with 3 points.
