EDITORIAL

Our worthy Treasurer was telling me recently that very few of the Counties had paid their dues for this season, and he found some difficulty in getting replies from some County Treasurers. I have no doubt that most County Treasurers are having the same trouble in getting the dues from the clubs under their jurisdiction, and it may well be that Club Treasurers are also having difficulties in obtaining subscriptions from members. And so, because of the slackness of some club members, the finances of the clubs, the Counties, the Union and the B C F are still in a low state, although the season is nearly over! At meetings of Executive Committees at all levels plans for future activities cannot be properly considered if the Treasurer does not know or cannot forecast what funds he will have available to meet expenses. Because of this, many good ideas fail to mature, and the average chess player begins to grumble that the County, the Union and the B C F are doing nothing. Can you, dear reader, if you are a member of a club, find out whether your Treasurer has paid your club's dues to the County, and if not, why not? If you are connected with the running of the County Association can you find out whether the County's dues have been paid, and if not, why not? And please urge the defaulters at all levels to pay up quickly, so that those who are trying to plan can know what money is available to meet expenses.

Some five or six years ago, the S C C U organised a County Jamboree to celebrate the eightieth birthday of Sir George Thomas, and this event has become a popular annual fixture. I now learn that the Oxfordshire Chess Association is proposing to recognise the long and devoted services of Professor H Simpson, to chess in that area, by holding a large scale Jamboree in honour of the Professor's 90th birthday.

The Jamboree will take place on Saturday, April 30th, in the Town Hall, Oxford. The competition will be for teams of six players, and there will be two three hour sessions, 11a.m. to 2 p.m., and 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., with one game in each session. Teams will be arranged in sections according to strength, and it is hoped to include a junior section for schools. Adult players are asked to pay 5s. per head, juniors 2s.6d. There will be a reception by the Lord Mayor of Oxford at 10 a.m. and play will start promptly at 11 a.m. Arrangements are being made for a late lunch at moderate terms between sessions, and the Organiser, Mr. R G K Bourbour of 56 Hamilton Road, Summertown, Oxford will be pleased to know in advance how many players wish to be catered for. Please send entries, not later than Monday 18th April to Mr. Bourbour, and each team should bring three clocks, boards and sets.

Will County officials please bring this event to the notice of their clubs, and, if possible, consider entering a County side. Unfortunately the date clashes with a meeting of the B C F Executive Committee, so that some of the Union's enthusiasts will not be available - but it is probably true to say that most of those attending this meeting are not in the top six players of any County! I feel sure that those who do participate will have an enjoyable time..... and if the response is as good as the cause deserves, then this too, may become an annual fixture.
