EDITORIAL

It is always difficult to know when to produce a fresh number of this Bulletin. It think most of the results are now in, but we cannot yet say which county is the Champion. Essex and Sussex, who are to be congratulated on winning their divisions, have yet to play each other. Sussex won their Quarter final in the Counties Championship, and played the semi-finals last week-end, but I have not yet had the result. Nor have I heard how Essex fared in the Quarter final.

We can however congratulate D B Pritchard on winning the Individual Championship in quite a strong competition, and S Webb of Oxted Surrey in winning the Under 18 Championship. Details of these competitions and the County Championship results will be found in the following pages, together with the full results of Junior Chess competitions in which the Union is interested.

We should, too, congratulate the few who spend so much time energy and patience in organising the Congresses at Folkestone, Richmond and Southend on Sea. All three were highly successful, and gave much pleasure to those who participated. The same also applies, of course, to the Whitsun Congress at Ilford. The Union can be very grateful to these hard workers who do so much for the benefit of so many of our players of all grades. Details of the Marlow Congress to be held over the August Bank Holiday are given with this issue. The Congress takes place in a very pleasant room and if you know of anyone wanting to take part in such an event - do please let them have full details as shown in the accompanying pamphlet. These weekend Congresses are the best way of entering the "play to a finish" competitions which most of us playing in League matches are unable to experience often.

A good many Congresses are of course available for those who wish to spend a week or a fortnight by the seaside. The B C F Congress this year takes place at Sunderland and there is still time to enter for competitions other than the British Championship. Details can be obtained from Mr. I Cohen, 48 Beacontree Avenue, Walthamstow, London E 17. Other Congresses are being held at Eastbourne - apply to B H Wood, Chess, Sutton Coldfield, Warwickshire; Whitby - apply Chess Congress, Whitby, Yorks; and Paignton (one week in September) - apply F E Willett, 25 Vapron Road, Plymouth, S Devon.

Meantime, let us look forward to the 1966/67 season, and hope for better personal results in our efforts to enjoy the game of Chess.

BOGNOR REGIS CONGRESS

Again, the only results I have seen are those of the Churchill Memorial Tournament in which seventy four players took part. Over 400 players participated in the whole Congress, and, as usual, the arduous work of Mr J N Fishlock-Lomax in organising such a strong foreign entry enabled it to maintain its high standard and popularity.

Players from the Southern Union clubs were much in evidence in the main tournament, M J Basman of Surrey finished equal third and won the prize for the best-placed home entrant. Equal seventh were P N Lee and A Whiteley of Oxford, T Hart and A K May of Surrey and O M Hindle of Norfolk whilst J N Walker, Oxford, J N Sugden, Kent, R G Wade, Middlesex, H Golombek Buckinghamshire, G J Nicholas, Sussex and D E Lloyd of Middlesex finished equal fourteenth.

The titles and Trophies for all sections of the S C C U Junior Championships, except the Under 18's Boys and Girls were, by agreement with Mr. J N Fishlock-Lomax, awarded to the leading eligible Southern Counties player in each of the six junior championship tournaments at the Butlin Open Chess Championships at Bognor Regis. So far, I have not heard who were the winners.

Hearty congratulations to Mr H Golombek on the award of the O. B. E in this year's Queen's Birthday Honours List, "for his services to Chess!"

JUNIOR CHESS

The Southern Counties Under 18 Inter County Jamboree finally took place on the 5th March, and teams from ten Counties entered.
