D. Lees of Bury, Lancashire won first prize of £ 20 with 5/6, Second to Fourth, with 4½/6 were J. Enticknap of Islington, Dr. J.T. Farrand of Chelmsford and Roger Lancaster of Croydon. They each received £ 6. R.A. Doney, K.B. Harman, A. Mazitis, D. Wright, T. Janikowski and T.D. Harding all scored 4/6. The latter two players shared the prize for the highest placed competitor with a rating of under 170. P. Burger won the prize for the highest placed player with a rating under 160 with 3/6.

S.C.C.U. Annual Jamborice

For the sixth time in as many years I have the pleasure of reporting to readers of the bulletin the highlights of another team Jamboree and the customary pre-match luncheon. This year Dr.M.R.Porter of Essex presided and our guestsof honour were Mr.H.Golembek, OBE, and Mr Owen Dixson, who came as the representative of the John Lewis Partnership. The Union Vice-President, Mr Ralph.C.Hopton of Bucks proposed the toast of the B.C.F. with which he coupled the name of Mr.Harry Golembek, whose recent honour gave so much pleasure to chessplayers all over the world. Replying on behalf of the Federation, Mr.Golombek, who described himself as a 'promoted pawn', thanked us for our good wishes and told us that the most pleasant part of his recent honour had been the messages and letters he had received from so many of his chess friends. In proposing the toast of the Union, Sir Frederick Hoare, the B.C.F.President, expressed our thanks to Miss Eileen Tranmer who has controlled the London Matches at John Lewis's during the past year and has rendered in valuable help to all who have played there. Dr.Porter in reply on behalf of the Union thanked Sir Frederick for his good wishes and also asked Mr.Owen Dixson to convey our thanks to the John Lewis Partnership for their help and hospitality over the past season. Luncheon concluded, the players repaired to the lower floor and the battle over the 100 boards soon got under way.

There were 20 competing teams, as in 1965, but although the teams came from the same counties and organisations, the final results completely confounded those prophets who expected a repetition of the 1965 scores. Considerable improvement was shown by Middlesex Seniors who scored 8 points and tied with Kent Seniors for first place as compared with the 10th place they occupied in 1965. Essex Seniors rose from 9th place to 3rd, Middlesex Juniors from 15th to 8th, and best of all Hants Seniors finished equal 5th against 16th. All of this was eclipsed on the debit side by last years winners, Cambridge University, who fell from grace in scoring only two points and achieving equal 19th place! The figures in parentheses are the total scores of the ten teams against the players in each team played and have been used to determine the order of teams with equal scores. I believe these figures can be studied with some interest by those who have to organise competitions run on a Jamboree basis - the disparity between Hants Seniors (40) and the Presidents Team (60) may in some degree account for the difference in their final scores, no doubt a perfect system of seeding the draw might bring better results and reduce the disparity gap shown in this instance, but for the present we have to do our best with the material available.

Once again we enjoyed the services of a number of people whose calm efficiency in their respective jobs made the administrative side of the Jamboree look very easy. Miss Tranmer and Mr.Peter Saw had the assistance of Mr Atkinson and Mr D Castello early in the afternoon and all sets and clocks were ready in good time.

Miss Titcomb and Mr.E.E.Croker kept the permanent records and Mr Sinclair and Mr Morrish again supplied a Wall Chart to show the players just how well (or badly) their team were doing. The Match Captains did a very good job - nearly all of them arrived in good time to get the players started soon after 3 O'clock and most players co-operated at the end of playing time by putting their sets in order and helping to return the material to the storage cupboard.

We can certainly look forward with pleasure to the next Jamboree, for which the date 18th November 1967 has been provisionally arranged, subject to the confirmation of the Fixtures Meeting this month. May I ask county secretaries to publicise this date among their players and suggest that more of them might like to attend the pre-match luncheon.
