The Second British Championship
SOUTHPORT 1905

This was the year in which the Federation rules were drawn up governing correspondence chess, inter-Unit correspondence competition, and the annual problem tourney.

The Congress was held at the Atkinson Art Gallery, Southport, from August 14th to the 26th. An innovation was an exhibition of 'Living Chess', G.E.H.Bellingham v Arthur Rutherford (the game can be found in Mason's "SOCIAL CHESS".) Six new names were seen in the Championship. The titleholder, Napier, had returned to the U.S.A.

Leicester born Atkins (1872-1955), in winning the first of his nine championships (seven consecutive), went through the tournament unbeaten. Blackburne lost to Sherrard and Wainwright. Atkins had previously shown his quality: he had played in all the cable matches against the U.S.A. winning four games out of eight, and at the Hanover Tournament, 1902, he won third prize in a tournament of 18 players, losing only to Pillsbury and Popiel.
