EDITORIAL

A Happy New Year to all our readers, and may all their games be interesting and enjoying whatever the results!

The weather and the threat of 'flu prevented my visiting the International Chess Congress at Hastings. I was, however, amused at the following extract from the report of the Sunday Telegraph reporter (published on the 4th January). This Sunday paper does not normally report the various chess Congresses, and I was therefore delighted when I saw that they had a short item about the Hastings Chess Congress. Five paragraphs, and these were the first four!

"King's Road fashion stormed its last improbable bastion at Hastings yesterday. At the International Chess Congress a competitor wore a maxi dress challenging the mini which was worn by a rival the day before.

The maxi, in "shocking pink" was teamed with a broad-brimmed black hat trimmed with snakeskin. It was worn by an attractive blonde, Miss Dinah Dobson, 23, of Northwood, Middlesex, the joint British ladies' champion.

Her rival in the challengers' reserve tournament section, Miss Ruth Cardoso, Brazilian and South American ladies' champion, who wore a black leather mini with brown leather boots and a bright yellow sweater. It was noticeable that the pair attracted a considerable gallery of the younger male spectators even in competition with four Grand Masters playing in the premier tournament.

In the chess field Miss Cardoso just holds the edge. She has beaten Miss Dobson in Holland and drawn with her at Belgrade and Hastings". Well, well! I hope to give news of how other of our Southern players fared in the next issue.

It is with regret that I learn that Reg Wilcocks will be resigning as Tournament Secretary from the end of the present season, owing to ill health. He was elected in 1964, so this will be his sixth season in a job which entails a lot of work as well as tact in dealing with County Match Captains! He has given the Union invaluable service and all players in all fourteen counties have benefitted from the strenuous efforts he has put in whilst organising the fixtures of the S C C U and looking after the adjudications and (occasional) arguments which arise. Let us hope that his health will improve and we shall see him from time to time. I know that members of the Council appreciate his past services.

The meeting for arranging the 1970/71 fixtures will be held in Room 18 at St Bride Institute on Saturday 8th February at 2.30 pm

Other information regarding S C C U matches which should have been played during October and November.
