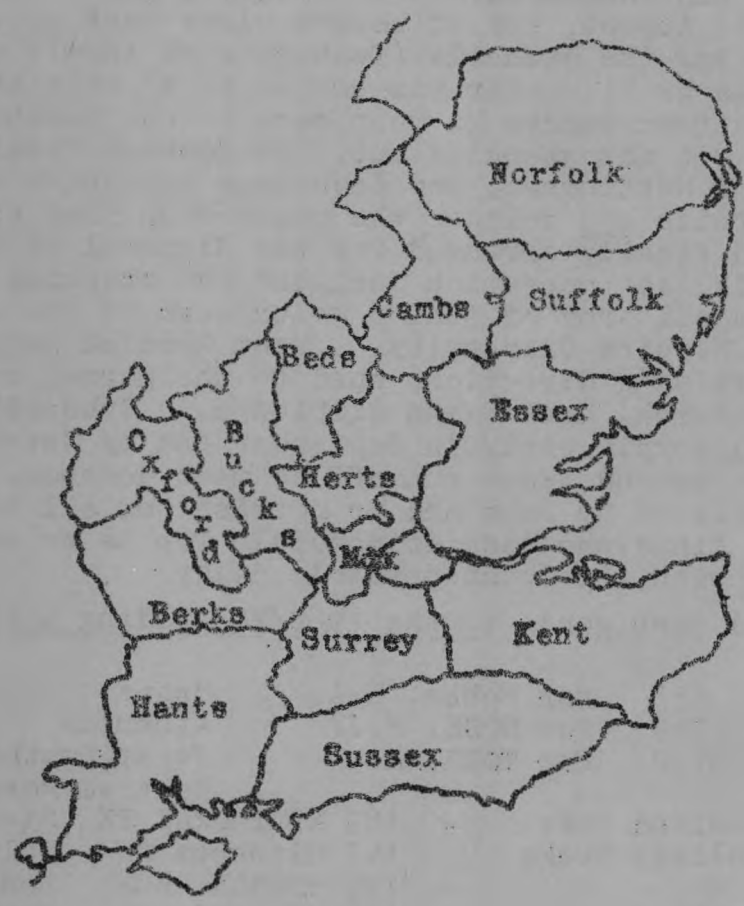

SUBSCRIPTION RATES

It is with much regret that the Executive Committee have to announce an increase in the subscription rates for the Bulletin effective from 9th October 1970 as follows:

Annual Subscription (Single Copy) six shillings 30 np

Three or more copies may be ordered for five shillings 25 np

September (Grading List) issues three shillings 15 np per copy post free, eight or more copies: two shillings and sixpence 12½ np each.

SEPTEMBER (Grading List) ISSUE

Now that the issue has passed the 800 mark it may be relevant to recall the difficulties of that particular issue and record our thanks to those who coped and conquered. The Grader's lists were completed in due time early in August, but it became clear that we were in for trouble in duplicating the stencils (Twentysix of them!) even when we had got them cut, as Mr Kilmister was unable to do this at the time required. In the circumstances Mr Owen came to our rescue and provided a typing group who got the stencils cut. Mr Morrish obtained the help of Mr A.J. Gillam of Nottingham, who possesses a machine which will both duplicate stencils and collate the pages when they are printed, to do this work and finally arranged for the disposal of the 750 copies thus produced. This last operation included the stapling of each copy with the aid of a small army of junior volunteers at the end of the B.C.F. Congress at Warwick University. From Warwick large consignments, under Mr Morrish's direction, sped to the normal centres of delivery at Christchurch, Marlow and Wimbledon. Subscribers began to receive their usual supply early in September and by October it was necessary to have a second issue run off to meet demands. We are most grateful for the help of Mr Owen and Mr Morrish and all those people along the delivery lines who made it possible for us to produce this largest-ever issue with the least possible delay.

GAMING BOARD for GREAT BRITAIN

Mr Owen has received the notice quoted below from the Secretary of the Board and it is passed on to any chess club officials to whom it may be of some concern:-

The Sale, Supply & Maintenance of Gaming & Amusement Machines

The Gaming Board have nearly completed their examination of the initial round of applications for certificates under Section 27 of the Gaming Act 1968 and most of the successful applicants have been informed.

From 1 October 1970 it will be illegal (apart from certain exceptions specified in subsections 2 & 4 of Section 27) to sell, supply or maintain a gaming machine without a certificate or permit issued by the Board. Please bring this to the notice of any of your members who may be concerned with the use of machines so that they can satisfy themselves that they deal only with authorised holders of certificates or permits.
