

"FRIENDS - OF - CHESS"

The Editor has no hesitation in inviting all readers of this page to consider the 1971 Report of the Friends of Chess in which are recorded a number of instances where the Friends have made specific contributions to chess activities during the past year. Also attention should be given to the further list of events which the Friends propose to help during the 1971-72 season.

Contributions have been made to the current Hastings Christmas Tournament which has been raised to major Grandmaster Level, the first such event in this country for twenty years. A sum of £600 has been allocated in support of an International Junior Tournament to be held at Norwich in April 1972 and contributions are also earmarked for experimental programmes for training and preparation for international events, teaching by Grandmasters, provision of technical information, etc.

In his report, the Chairman, Sir Richard Clarke, K.C.B., O.B.E., states "The purpose of the Friends is to improve Britain's position in international chess. We are an independent body, concerned only with this one objective. We are affiliated to the British Chess Federation and work closely and happily with the Federation. We do not run tournaments, or select teams ourselves; we are promoters of international chess events and leave the organisation and management to the people who are qualified to do it."

INTER-COUNTY MATCHES - DEFAULTS:

Mr A.J. Douglas writes: Whilst unfortunately some defaults are inevitable in team matches there have been occasions recently when some county sides have defaulted on nearly half their boards. When this has occurred it has naturally caused some resentment from players who may have travelled some distance and then had no game.

If therefore Match Captains know beforehand that they are likely to default on a number of boards, the Executive Committee has asked that as a matter of courtesy they should notify their opposite numbers in good time so that they may modify their arrangements if they so wish.

LONDON JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:

These Championships were held at the Sarah Siddons School, Paddington, London, W.2. from Tuesday 28th December 1971 until Monday, 3rd January, 1972 and attracted 480 entries in all.

The Under-21 Championship was won by M.J. Yeo (Queens College, Cambridge), scoring 4 out of 5 games. Second came M.J. Lightfoot (Richmond), N.E. Povah (Streatham & Brixton) and D.H. Powell (Ashford, Kent), each of whom scored 3½.

The Under-18 Event was won by the youngest entrant, T.P.D. Chapman (Wimbledon) with 9½ out of 11. Second was K.L. Howells (St Albans) with third place shared by J.M. Bennett (Battersea), T. Parkes (Edmonton) and D.R. Sedgwick (Croydon).

The Under-16 event. Jonathan Kinlay (Orpington) scored 7 out of 11 to take 1st place. C.S. Crouch (Harrow) and A. Shah (Hammersmith) shared 2nd place.

Jonathan C. Benjamin (Richmond) won the Under-14 event with 8½/11 and three players, G. Abayeskara (Woking), S. Fancy (Charlton), and D. Kerr (Ewell) finished equal second.

In the Under-12 competition, the first 11 rounds produced a triple tie with Alastair Dunleavy (Wallington), J.J. Kennedy (Thomas Calton School) and D.P. White (St Joseph's), each scoring 9 points. In the play-off Dunleavy and Kennedy scored 1½ each and so share the title.
