

## FRIENDS OF CHESS

It is always appropriate for any Chess Player to ask how this country stands in the World of International Chess and for far too many years such a question received a rather dusty answer. This year the annual report of the Friends of Chess is able to give a slightly better answer, reminding us that Hastings became a major Grandmaster Tournament in 1971, will be again this Christmas with permanence in this grade. Further we had another major Grandmaster Tournament at Teeside, the strongest held in this country since 1936. When one adds the performance of our young players at the strong Junior International Tournament at Norwich and our success in the Olympiad (albeit only in Section B) a little hope for the future seems visible.

Which brings me back to the Friends of Chess whose growth during their three years of existence since 1969 is reflected in an increase in the net income from £925 in 1970 to £1,538 this year. Their 1972 contribution to our international chess events amounted to £1,981 and the three years total was £2,403 with a commitment for 1972/73 exceeding £1,000. The total expenditure in this country on International Chess events is probably around £15,000 to £20,000, of which the Friends provide about ten per cent directly.

As at the end of June the Friends numbered 31 patrons and 133 members and their target was 40 patrons and 160 members. Sir George A. Thomas, Bart. The national press and all Chess periodicals have given ample reports of the death in July last of Sir George at the age of 91. Many older readers will recall his appearances for Hampshire over the years and of course, his international career is well-known to all. The S.C.C.U. counties will recall that our first inter-county Jamboree, now an established event, was held in 1961 to celebrate Sir George's 80th birthday. We all mourn the loss of one who was probably our most outstanding player of this century and whose quiet courtesy and generosity was an example to several generations of chess enthusiasts.

George F. Maynard We regret to learn that a tragic road accident in September deprived the Guildford Chess Club and Surrey of a valued and universally popular member. George Maynard was the Match Captain of the Guildford Club, of which he had been a member for many years playing regularly in their team, a competitor in several Congresses as well as a reliable county player from time to time. He will be greatly missed by his many friends and our sympathies go to his widow and children.

After reading the above paragraph it may come as a surprise to readers to know that the September issue may be the last to contain a Grading List. As everyone knows (or should know) basic grading is done by a number of devoted enthusiasts in various leagues and all our counties, who examine all match and tournament results and assess the grading number of each player on the results of these games. At the end of the playing season, April or thereabouts, the new grading data goes to Mr Felce, the Union Grader, who collates them into the annual List which we publish each September. The operation thus simply described occupies at least 500 man-hours concentrated in nine or ten weeks between early June and Mid-August and Mr Felce has had to inform us that he will be unable to do this in future years. We are therefore needing a replacement (or replacements) for Mr Felce to be fully trained by next May and we have a very short time to find and train new personnel for this most important task. The Executive Committee at their last meeting asked me to bring this to the notice of all our readers and invite immediate offers of help - if you can help please inform Mr Locke at once, because although Mr Felce is able and willing to instruct his successor(s), he is unable to do the job next June. WE HAVE TO PRODUCE THE WORKER(S) OR GO WITHOUT A GRADING LIST.

INTER-COUNTY MATCHES The following pages give the first results of our new-style matches wherein teams play a minimum of 20 boards in four competitions. As readers will observe, the first batch is not without its surprises, but the Fixtures Secretary is well pleased with the response to our revised programme. Apart from the sad lapse by Oxford, defaults seem to be few and far between and adjudications are not too numerous by recent standards. In our next issue, we may have sufficient results to warrant publishing one or two tables to show how the counties stand.
