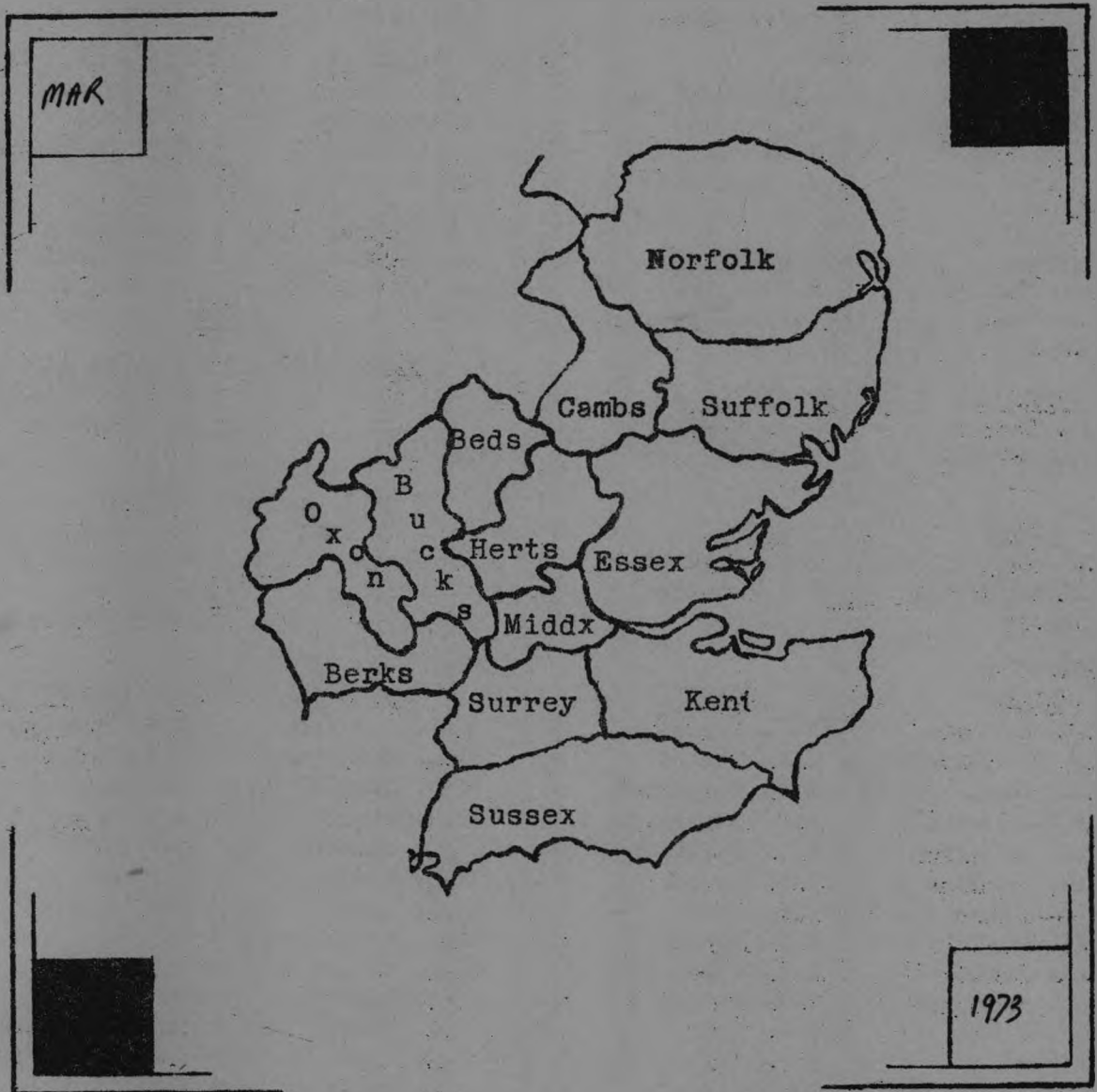

OBITUARY : Miss Hilda Titcomb.

Brian Gould writes: "The death of Hilda Titcomb in her sleep ten days before Christmas followed the pattern of her life: in faith, in her native Godalming and with her unselfish energy still undiminished." In its use music and chess came first. She had held official posts of the kind which mean hard work without limelight for the S.C.C.U. and for Surrey C.C.A. and remained secretary of the Godalming Club and a regular member of the Guildford Club as long as she lived; She was also a warm admirer and staunch supporter of the late Normal Fishlock-Lomax in his work for the Bognor Congresses. One of her kin has said "She went out on the crest of a wave." Hilda Titcomb's death was not sad, but she will be sadly missed.

The 'Surrey Times' reported details of her interest in the Godalming Trust of which she was Treasurer, in the Godalming Operatic Society and in Busbridge Church and Holy Trinity Church, Guildford. The funeral took place at Guildford Crematorium, Broadwater, on 20th December.

Over 500 competitors took part in the 1973 events which were again held at the Sarah Siddons School, Paddington, under the guidance of Mr Peter Morrish and a small army of very competent controllers. Winners were:

London Under-21 Championship: Nigel E. Povah of Streatham & Brixton Club. 2nd J.D.M. Nunn of Kingston Club. 3rd J.G. Nicholson of Dulwich College.

Senior Under-18 Championship: Peter M. Broad of Whitgift School 8½/11. Equal 2nd M.P. Hubbard of Tom Hood School and Jonathan Kinlay of Sevenoaks School with 8/11. (46 competitors).

Girls Under-18 Championship: Wanda H. Z. Pritchard of Guildford High School with 6/6. 2nd was eleven-year-old Suzanne J. Wood of Edmonton County School with 5/6 and 3rd Bryony M. Coote of Rodborough School and Reshma Hasnain of Dick Sheppard School with 4/6.

Intermediate Under-16 was jointly won by Russell C. Picot of Whitgift School and Amer Shah of Henry Compton School with 9/11. 3rd was Stuart Fancy of Crown Woods School with 8½. (89 competitors).

Junior Under-14 Championship was won by David Okike of St Marylebone G.S. with 9/11 and no fewer than six players tied for 2nd place with 8/11 from a field of 88 competitors.

Girls Under-12 Championship: Suzanne J. Wood of Edmonton County School.

Boys Under-12 Championship: Nicholas R. Benjamin of Colet Court School with 7½/9 after a play-off with Julian Farino of St Joseph's College. 3rd Simon D. Brown of St Olave's G.S., Orpington 7/9. This event attracted 209 entrants who played in sections of 8 for the first day from which 60 were selected to play in the final 9-round Swiss.

GLORNEY CUP

Mr P.J. Ezra writes: "Some years ago a Trust was set up to promote a Junior tournament amongst the four home counties with the addition of two Continental countries whenever possible.

Teams consist of six juniors, plus a reserve and a non-playing Captain if required. The Tournament rotates between the four countries with an occasional Continental venue. Each host country is responsible for all the expenses of the tournament with the exception of travelling expenses borne by each individual competing country.

Income from the Glorney Trust is used to defray central administration expenses and act as banker of last resort should a country not be able to completely pay for their tournament when they were hosts.

For many years the English Teams have been financed by a levy on the Unions at a rate of £1 per county plus £2.50 for every player selected in that Union. This was agreed to in 1967. In addition the British Chess Federation made an annual grant of £20 and the players were expected to contribute £5 or £7.50 towards their travelling expenses, depending on whether it was a four or six country event. With other donations the English team income is in the region of £110 per season. Over the last three years this income has been sufficient to cover England's travelling expenses and leave a small surplus.

England were hosts in 1972 and the cost of staging the six-nation event was nearly £600. Using the above guaranteed income, all the accumulated surplus and by special appeals (the S.C.C.U. gave £50 in all) it was only possible to balance the account by appealing to the Trust to the extent of £136. This help virtually exhausted the income account of the Trust.

On the English Secretary's resignation, the B.C.F. have been asked to take over the financial side in addition to their existing selection duties. It is clear that the guaranteed income should be sufficient to cover the travelling expenses of the English team for the next few years. The 1973 event will be held in Dublin.

Assuming that there is no Continental invitation the big problem is that of 1976 when it will again be England's turn to be the hosts. Clearly it is morally wrong to continue to participate and then withdraw when it is England's turn to play host. Therefore if England is to continue to participate, then the finance must be considered on a four-year budget.

A reasonable estimate for this period would be about £1,200 or £300 per annum with guaranteed income at about a third of this amount.

The question is how is this to be done, if at all. There are several possibilities and your views, through your county representatives, are needed. WHAT DO YOU THINK?
