

EASTER CONGRESSES

FULKESTONE, controlled by Kent Secretary G.F. Steel, had 42 in the Premier 7-Round Swiss. Won by A.G. Trangmar with 6/7. 2nd with 5/7 were M.P. Cook, Kent; H. Hurter, West Germany; H. van Lord & J. Verhoes, Holland; C.J. Whittington, London. Major 5-Round Swiss had 44 entrants & won by K. Dekker, Holland 5/5. J. Hutcheson, Kent 2nd with 4½ and 4 players tied for 3rd place. The Main events had 4 sections of six and were won by: 1. Miss A.C. Lord, London 4½/5; 2. B. Hodgson and R.C. Shing 4/5; 3. A. Binns 4½/5; All of Kent. Junior event was won by L. Wooldridge from 8 entries.

HAMMERSMITH, controlled as usual by F.A. Winter, had 192 finishers in the Open Swiss. B. Kurajioa & T.D. Harding shared 1st place with 6½/7. J. Mestel, A. Melville and P.J. Stubbs shared 3rd place with 6/7. The Main produced 20 sections of 6, arranged according to grades. Top 'A' won by A.C.F. Milnes, Hampstead. 'B' by B.J. Franks of Atheneum with 4½. 'C' by J. Wilcox, Wimbledon 4½. Juniors had 10 sections and nearly 400 competitors took part. The Organisers are to be congratulated on a very competent effort.

SOUTHEND, controlled by J.A. Speigel, staged the Union Championship which was won by G.H. Bennett (Waltham Forest) with 5/6. B.L. McCague, Essex, came 2nd with 4½ and A.J. Stebbings 3rd with 4. There were 18 competitors for the Title. 84 players competed in the Open Championship which was won by D. Wright 6/7, followed by six players with 5½ - G.P. Burton; J.I. Century; L.A. Edwards; A. Pope; J.N. Sugden and D. Williams.

The S.C.C.U. Under-18 Championship was won by C.R. Chandler with 5/5. 3 tied for 2nd place with 3/5 - N. Cutler; B.W. Fryer and P.A. Young. The Minor event had 6 sections of 6. 'A' D.E. Begarnie & K.D. May tied for 1st Place. 'B' T. Pinkney. 'C' R.J. Thompson. The Major had 5 sections of 6, 'A' won by J.A. Dodgson. 'B' by G.I. Ladds and 'C' by J. Harvey. Four Junior sections of 6 were won by 'A' K. Ramage. 'B' C.R. Banbury. 'C' P. Holt. 'D' shared by K. Parslow and P.R. Salmon.

In the Lightning Tournament R. Payne, L.A. Edwards and A.J. Stebbings tied with 6/7. It was the intention of the Organisers to limit the entry to 200 and 199 took part. The thanks of all concerned are due to J.A. Speigel and his helpers, D. Eustace and C.M. Speigel for a well-run Congress.

JAMBOREES (Senior and Junior)

As the Chess season draws to its close, the Jamborees are with us, both Senior and Junior species. The Senior event took place on Saturday 7th April at Hurlingham School, under the control of our Vice-President, Mr R.L. Owen, ably assisted by Messrs E.T. Ruddle (Bucks) and M. Sinclair (Middlesex). Eleven Teams entered the event and the detailed results will be found on Page eight; six games have gone to adjudication. The current leaders are Sussex and Cambs with 7/9, Middlesex 6/9 and Essex 5/9.

Details of the Junior event will be found on Page Seven and Mr David Blackman writes:

"Not even the harmless pursuit of Junior Chess, it would seem, is immune from the effects of industrial disputes. Last year's Union Junior Jamboree narrowly escaped being blacked out by the power strike; this year's event was held at the height of the rail dispute. Several team captains were placed in a difficult situation of not knowing whether their players would arrive late, or for that matter arrive at all. Kent girls were worst hit, Mr Hannan had to find two last-minute reserves; including one in the place of the British girl champion, Susan Caldwell. Also, it was not until four hours before the start of the event that Sussex Girls knew that they would be able to come. However, despite these trials and tribulations, every participating county was able to field a full team, although several had to call on their reserve strength.

When the dust of the battle had settled on the adjudications, Middlesex emerged as winners of the Boys' Tournament with 9½ points, half a point ahead of Surrey. Kent and Berkshire were equal third with 7½. Essex won the Girls event, just edging Surrey out on Board Count. The result all depended on the last game to finish, in which Julia Park (Sussex) defeated Elaine Sadler (Surrey)".
