

STOP PRESS.

CORRECTION: Our December issue reported the 24-11-73 Montague-Jones match between Kent II and Surrey II as a win for Kent by  $11\frac{1}{2}$  -  $8\frac{1}{2}$ : The result of Board 8 should have been recorded as a draw, so that the correct result was a win for Kent II by 11-9.

APPEALS: In the County Championship match between Kent and Surrey, Kent appealed against the decision of the adjudicator on boards 4 and 9. There appeals were both upheld and the scores now read Board 4 Lambshire 1 Kooiman 0 and 9 Hanreok  $\frac{1}{2}$  Emerson  $\frac{1}{2}$ , making the final score Kent  $10\frac{1}{2}$  Surroy  $9\frac{1}{2}$ .

O B I T U A R Y : Mr C.H. O'D. Alexander, C.M.G., C.B.E.

Many thousands of chess players all over the world have by this time read with regret of the death of Mr Alexander and have read many tributes to him from many notable people. The Editor would like to reprint the following tribute which appeared in 'The Times' under the initials PSM-B:

"Without a doubt Hugh Alexander could have been a Grandmaster at chess but not even he could be a grandmaster in two professions, and he rightly gave priority to the Civil Service, in which he first made so notable a contribution during the War. After his retirement he intended to devote himself to writing about chess, but had only just embarked on the Fischer/Spassky book when he became desperately ill. Perhaps only Hugh himself thought that he could recover, but through the skill of his doctors and fortified by the sympathy and devotion of his friends (which greatly astonished him, for he had little idea of the affection and admiration which he inspired) he not only did so, but from his sick-room completed against time the whole of this brilliant work - a remarkable example of the tenacity, resourcefulness and sheer stamina which made him so formidable an opponent, especially in unfavourable positions.

For a further 18 months he enjoyed great happiness and contentment at his new home in Cheltenham. He wrote two more splendid books, and was well on the way to a third: and he made at gruelling cost a major personal contribution to the organisation of the European Team Tournament at Bath in July. When a short while ago he was again stricken down, his illness was mercifully brief. He continued working to the end, he maintained as always the liveliest interest in the doings of his family and friends, and he never realised that this was a game that even he could not save.

One could have wished for nothing else but that vivid and vigorous presence that quick clear and energetic mind, the passion for intellectual argument, the practical kindness and spontaneous understanding with the young - all this will be sadly missed. To have been so close a friend for 50 years is indeed good fortune."

G R A D I N G

The Hon. Secretary, Mr B.G. Locke, writes:-

The S.C.C.U. Executive Committee have been considering for some time the possibility that the annual preparation of the Grading List, which Mr Felce carries out, would have to be done by a computer owing to the increasing size of the job. Mr Felce has now had a major operation and is remaining in hospital for further treatment and we cannot expect that he will be able to prepare the Grading List this year. The Committee have therefore decided to have the grading scores collated by computer commencing this season. A meeting of graders is taking place on March 9th when we are asking them to take part of Mr Felce's records of our 12,000 players currently playing graded chess and prepare lists to be fed into the computer. This job will take at least 240 man-hours and if anyone is prepared to carry out say 10 hours work in the next three weeks (or even 5 hours, every little helps), please write to the Hon. SOUTHERN COUNTIES JUNIOR INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Mr David Blackman writes:-

"Thanks entirely to the efforts of Mr M.C. Thompson, the 1974 Under-12, Under-14 and Under-16 Individual Championships of the Union will be held at Butlin's Holiday Camp, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex from 17th to 20th April inclusive. (Wednesday afternoon, Thursday, Friday and Saturday morning). The entry fee for all tournaments will be 50p and all accommodation will be within the Camp. The cost for the four days will be approximately £8; all meals included. All Camp facilities will be available to competitors (swimming pool, table tennis, etc.). Rates of play are still under consideration and will obviously have to take account of meal times. By the time this appears in print, all County Junior Organisers will have been notified of the details, but it must be emphasised that Butlins MUST know the number of competitors by March 18th. (We wanted a closing date of 1st April, but Butlins would not hear of it). Details may be obtained from Mr M.C. Thompson, 9 Cary Close, Wash Common, Newbury, Berkshire. Telephone Newbury 4418. If sufficient girls enter, separate Tournaments will be run for them. See Under-18 announcement and other details on Page Two."

The Under-18 Championships will be held, as last year, in conjunction with the Southend-on-Sea Easter Congress, details from J.A. Speigel, 28a Boscombe Road, Southend-on Sea, Essex.

It is possible that some readers might find the wording in the Southend entry form slightly ambiguous and that it could be interpreted to mean that Mr Blackman should receive all the entries for the whole of the Congress - this is not the case, all that Mr Blackman wants are the entries for the S.C.C.U. B.C.F. MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP: This season only two of our counties showed any interest in this event, the match on 9th February will probably count for the M.C.C. and the winner will go into the National semi-final. It may be of some interest to readers to learn that last year's final of this event was won over the board by Lancs II and originally awarded to Middlesex II because their opponents suffered the deduction of one point from their score for including an ineligible player; the trophy has now been reawarded to Lancs II because of a similar offence by Middlesex!! Anyone who cares to read the relevant rule of the M.C.C. will probably not be surprised to hear of inadvertent infringements - whether any S.C.C.U. counties will enter such a competition next season must be regarded as speculative to say the least of it. -----

B.C.F. REGISTRATION FEES: In view of the present trend of price inflation, the B.C.F. proposed that in future the affiliation fee for club members should be raised from the present level of 25p per capita to 50p. This proposal was considered by the Union Executive Committee, who agreed that some rise was inevitable, but considered that 100% was not justified. The matter has gone to various B.C.F. Committees and the result of their deliberations will be put before the Executive of the Federation on 9th March and advised to all Unions thereafter. -----
