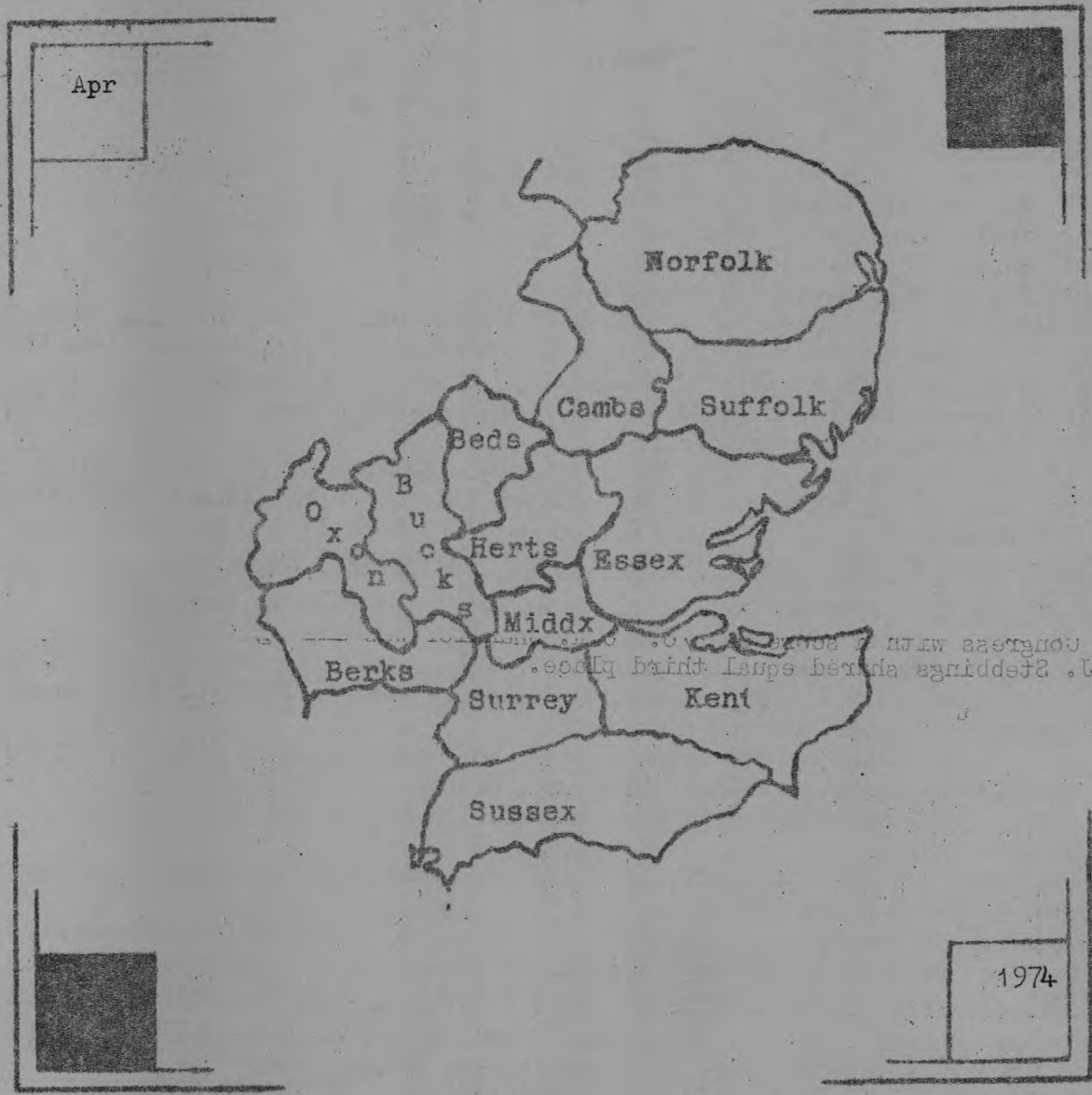

O B I T U A R Y : Mr A.E. Hopkins. Mr E.F. Croker writes:

Albert E. Hopkins of Harrow and Hayes Chess Clubs, who was the founder Editor and Producer of this Bulletin from 1958 to 1963, died on 10th March, 1974, just before his 78th birthday. Although born on Kumberside and brought up in Hull he moved, after service in the first world war, to the London Area where he worked as a school teacher in Islington for almost forty years. He first played chess for Middlesex in December and he remained an active player to the end. He won the Harrow Club championship in years as far apart as 1933 and 1963. He was a prominent member of his clubs and gave occasional chess lectures at Harrow, but he will certainly be best remembered for his services to junior chess. These increased during the years - broadly those following his retirement from 1955 to 1968 when he was an honoured member of the B.C.F. Junior Committee. He ran the Junior County Finals, organised the England Glorney Cup (Under-18) team and was active in the Chess Education Society, first as Hon. Secretary and then as Vice-President. He was our S.C.C.U. Junior Organiser from 1957 to 1964, a period of steady expansion, particularly in the S.C.C.U. Junior events at Bognor and he was also largely responsible for the growth of the London Junior Championships during his reign as Chief Controller. Nor were his interests confined to Chess; Bridge players tell us he had a natural flair for the game and at one time he was the proud partner of Emanuel Lasker.

Yet all this does no more than state mere facts about a man whose genial north country roar became so well known to many young people. He was fond of describing himself as "always a junior", and because he identified himself closely with the aspirations of those still in their teens, the funeral of this bachelor, with no surviving close relatives, was attended by some three dozen people, most of them chess players whom he had encouraged in their early years and who remembered him with deep affection.
