TONY MILES - BRITAIN'S FIRST INTERNATIONAL GRANDMASTER

Tony achieved the first of his 'GM norms' by winning the London Evening Standard Grandmaster Tournament in 1975. Finishing ahead of 4 GMs, Adorjan (Hungary), Timman (Holland), Sax (Hungary) and Sigurjonsson (Iceland) and scoring $\frac{1}{2}$ point over the 'GM norm' with $7\frac{1}{2}/10$, he needed one other similar result for the Grandmaster title.

Three times since, with excellent results he has on each occasion fallen short of this further requirement. In the Alexander Memorial Tournament at Teesside he was the highest placed Englishman, but on $6\frac{1}{2}/14$ was still one point short. At Novi Sad in October he scored $9\frac{1}{2}/15$, equal second ahead of four GMs, but again a point short. Then at Hastings, he was stopped by a loss to Ray Keene finishing with $7\frac{1}{2}/15$, again the top English player.

Finally, at the age of 20, at Dubna, near Moscow, where he was the only Westerner to compete in a 16 player international tournament, he finished equal 3rd with Suetin and Gipslis, behind Zeshkovski and Zaitsev (all USSR). His score at $9/15$, just sufficient to achieve the second 'norm' and thereby the title of Grandmaster.

It should be noted that Tony's title is for 'over the board' play. GM titles are also held by Comins Mansfield for chess composition, Keith Richardson for correspondence chess, and R W Bonham for correspondence chess for the blind.

OBITUARY

Ralph L. Barnett, MBE, C.Eng, MIEE

The sudden death of Ralph Barnett, who died in his sleep from a coronary attack on 29 January 1976, aged 64, is a very great loss to Middlesex chess and his sound counsel and friendliness will be sadly missed by all who knew him. Ralph had been a prominent member of his works' club, EMI., and of the County Association since the late 1940's and since 1960 had been Hon. Treasurer of Middlesex, an office he fulfilled with efficiency and distinction. For many years he was a member of the Council of the Union, serving on the Executive from 1962 until 1970 and for some years represented us on the Council of the B.C.F.

Ralph Barnett was a moderate but enthusiastic player whose grading fluctuated between the 160's and 180's. He played regularly for EMI in the Middlesex League, for Middlesex in the County Championship and other competitions with consistent, if not spectacular results. Ralph was one of those invaluable team players upon whom match captains can always depend to fill a last-minute vacancy, irrespective of the distance to be travelled. As County Match Captain for many years I frequently called upon his services in this way and he never let me down.

Ralph Barnett graduated from Queen Mary College, London University, and was employed by EMI as a Chartered Engineer for 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ years, being awarded the MBE in 1967 for his services. To his widow, who has done so much unseen work for Middlesex CCA, and to his family, we extend our sincere condolences in their untimely loss.

BOOK LIST The best games of C H O'D Alexander, H Golombek & W R Hartston Oxford University Press pp 164. £5.95 net in U.K.
