

BCF NEWS FLASH March and April issues

MCCU Chess Letter end February

Surrey Chess News March issue.

In the March issue of the NEWSFLASH, the B.C.F. Secretary, Mr. Paul Buswell wrote as follows:-

'This month's editorial comment must surely be devoted to the meeting of the BCF Executive Committee on 26th February. This meeting was convened specially to act upon, if it deemed fit, a report from a working party of the Development Committee. This report was the culmination of efforts by various committees during the past 2½ years and concerned itself with the administration of the BCF was not effective, insofar as the committee structure is time-consuming and acts against decisive action being taken by the Federation on any issue. The report felt that drastic changes were necessary within the Federation to enable the Federation to actively pursue its aims and objectives and, in short, to give it a new image. It is not the place of this Editorial to argue the pros and cons of the report or to attempt to produce critique of it; that would be a major work the report's theme can best be expressed by noting below the recommendations which were eventually with varying degrees of consent, adopted by the Executive Committee:

- "(1) The BCF shall be reconstituted as the English Chess Federation.
- (2) The aims and objects of the ECF shall be those of the BCF, but in an English context (except for the British Championships).
- (3) To efficiently pursue its aims and objects the ECF shall, under the Council, be managed by a Chief Executive and Policy Board: responsibility for and authority over sectors of chess activity shall be concentrated in fewer hands.
- (4) The finances of the ECF as raised from its members shall be principally related to Grading, the ECF's most popular service.
- (5) The administrative infrastructure of the ECF shall be strengthened by placing responsibility with Regional bodies who shall be expected to respond to the pressures of the decision-making process."

Please note that these resolutions have been passed in principle. The Working Party is now, in conjunction with the official draftsman, to prepare detailed resolutions where appropriate in the hope that it will be possible to submit them to the BCF Council in July, although it is realised that not all resolutions could be implemented in time.

Please remember that these are resolutions agreed in principle and that no change to the Constitution of the British Chess Federation can take place without the consent of the Council on which all Counties and Affiliates are represented. The report seen by the Executive Committee will in the very near future be circulated to the Counties and Affiliates and it is through your membership of them that you should voice any opinions which you wish to have heard, and it is through them that you can express your satisfaction or dissatisfaction with the proposed restructuring of the BCF. I anticipate that there will be much debate and discussion throughout the Federation as a result of the Executive Committee's decision and this debate and discussion can take place at all levels of the Federation. Whatever the outcome the resolutions of the Executive Committee mark a milestone in the history of the BCF and I urge all Counties and Affiliates, and their members to exercise responsibility when considering these matters.'

The final report of the working party was issued to members of the BCF Executive prior to their meeting on 26th February but there was insufficient time for the Union Executive Committee members to be consulted. At the BCF meeting a report was presented by the Federation Hon. Treasurer, Mr. P J Ezra but this had not been circulated prior to the meeting. It was felt that our Union Executive should consider both reports and copies were issued to all members of our Executive and also to secretaries of our member counties. At their April meeting the Union Executive will discuss the BCF proposals in the light of these reports and make their recommendations to the Annual meeting of the Council of the Union. - - - JJL. - - -
