

EDITORIAL

In his penultimate offering the Editor would ask his readers to re-read the letter which our President, Mr Brian Locke, wrote in our March issue:

"The SCCU is about to lose several of its present office holders and I would appreciate it if anyone who would be interested in taking on work at Union level would get in touch with our Hon. Secretary, Harold Bitton, whose address appears in the heading of the Bulletin, or myself.

"David Eustace is resigning as our Junior Organiser and Bryan Threadgall and his wife as our Bulletin producers (typing and duplicating). Mr JJ Lauder has already announced his own resignation as stated in the January Bulletin and his work involves distributing as well as editing the Bulletin. Eric Croker wishes to give up his work as our junior grader and whilst we are exploring the possibility of coping with this by computer, there will be a great deal of administration involved as well.

"If you have editorial or administrative talents, please don't be backward in coming forward. We will always be prepared to divide a job or even alter it to fit your particular abilities and wishes. Alternatively if you know of someone whom you think we should approach, please let Mr Bitton or myself know."

Since that was written, Richard Haddrell of Kent has undertaken to produce the next two issues (May and July) and on the other hand Mr Emerson has asked that an assistant Hon. Treasurer be appointed next month with a view to taking over the post of Hon. Treasurer in a year's time. The Editor would conclude by suggesting that Bulletin subscribers in general and Executive members in particular might give some more thought to the problems facing the Union and come forward at the Annual Council Meeting with some practical suggestions.

SCCU TROPHIES

Mr AJ Douglas writes: We are still trying to trace the Union trophies of which the following is a list: Shannon Trophy, Glenroy Cup, Stevenson Trophy, Henlen Trophy, Southdean Cup, Walker Cup, six Montrose Cups, Fleming Cup and Anness Cup. Unfortunately the whereabouts of the above-listed trophies is unknown and anyone who has any information which might help in locating any of them is asked to advise the Tournament Secretary, or any other Committee member.

In addition to those listed above, there are the Montague-Jones Cup, and the Amboyna and Ebony Shields, but we do not know where these are. I would also take this opportunity of asking any trophy holder to return such trophies to the Tournament Secretary or other Committee member at or before the Annual Council Meeting.

BCF RE-ORGANISATION

The Special Council Meeting of the Federation last month completed the constitutional establishment of the new Management Board, whose members replace the former Executive and all standing committees. It was decided to retain the "British" title of the Federation and the General Secretary's duties specifically include general executive powers but his title remains unchanged. The post of Publicity Director has yet to be filled and the modus operandi of payment by grading will be studied in detail for some time. Mr Locke advised the BCF Council that we could devise a method of meeting the demands of the present proposals by use of the computer, but this could not operate until 1979/80, always assuming that the SCCU approved the principle of payment by grading, which our Counties have not yet done.

(The method we could use has been examined by a sub-committee of the Union Executive, and would involve the issue of a list of players grouped into their clubs, but this could not be done before September 1979 and the first grading list in the approved form would be that issued in 1980.)

CONGRESS RESULTS

The Aaronson Masters Tournament attracted an entry of 72, of whom 19 (including 5 IM's) were foreign and 4 British IM's, for a 10 round Swiss at the Imperial Hotel, London, during the week 23rd - 29th March. After ten gruelling rounds IM Aldo Haik of France and Michael Franklin of Surrey shared the £350 prize with $7\frac{1}{2}$ pts. Equal third came three IM's: WR Hartston, MC Diesen (USA) and B Soos (DDR) with 7 pts and £73 each. Equal 6th were R Bailey of Berks and IM's JDM Nunn and A Arnstein of Sweden whose $6\frac{1}{2}$ pts earned them £10 each. IM norms were achieved by seven players: Franklin, Bellin, Botterill, Garbett (NZ), Law and Sliman (USA) - of whom Bellin is now qualified for the IM title. Twelve year old Nigel Short, who attracts a great deal of publicity for the game, making his first attempt at an IM norm lost to the three IM's he met but took $5\frac{1}{2}/7$ against the rest of his opponents, sharing equal 21st place with 12 other competitors including one IM and three foreign players.

The Eleventh East Anglian Congress at Norwich over the weekend 31st March - 2nd April accepted 128 players. The Premier winner was C Cubitt with $4\frac{1}{2}/5$; 2nd SW Ruthen (Norfolk and Norwich) 4; =3rd EG Davies (Norfolk and Norwich), G Evans (Gorleston S) $3\frac{1}{2}$. The Premier reserves was won by CJ Goodwin (Cambs) $4\frac{1}{2}$; =2nd M Shannahan (Bury), S Randall (Norfolk and Norwich), JF Lambert (Prescot) $3\frac{1}{2}$. Major "A": =1st TW Harle (Camden), K McEwan (Sproston), RJ Woodcraft (Ipswich) $4/5$. Major "B": =1st IH Stanley, K Chapman $4\frac{1}{2}$; =3rd J Emms, M Madden $3\frac{1}{2}$ (all Norfolk and Norwich). The Minor Senior was won by RA Clegg (N and N) and the Junior section by GI Lyon (Gorleston).

The 22nd Southend on Sea Easter Congress attracted 244 competitors of whom 136 were in the Open event. =1st with $6/7$ were DJ Coleman, GJ Moore (both of Marlow), C Gilliam (Mitcham) and L Prins (Holland); =5th JA Didgson, AE Hanreck (both of Kent), E Lea (Sussex), DJ Faulkner (Bucks) and M Goll (Lincs) who also won the under-161 grading prize ($5\frac{1}{2}$). Twelve Major and Minor plus two Junior sections were played and two section winners, T Coote (Essex) (Minor "C") and E Rattner (Southend) (Junior "B") had 100% scores with $5/5$.
