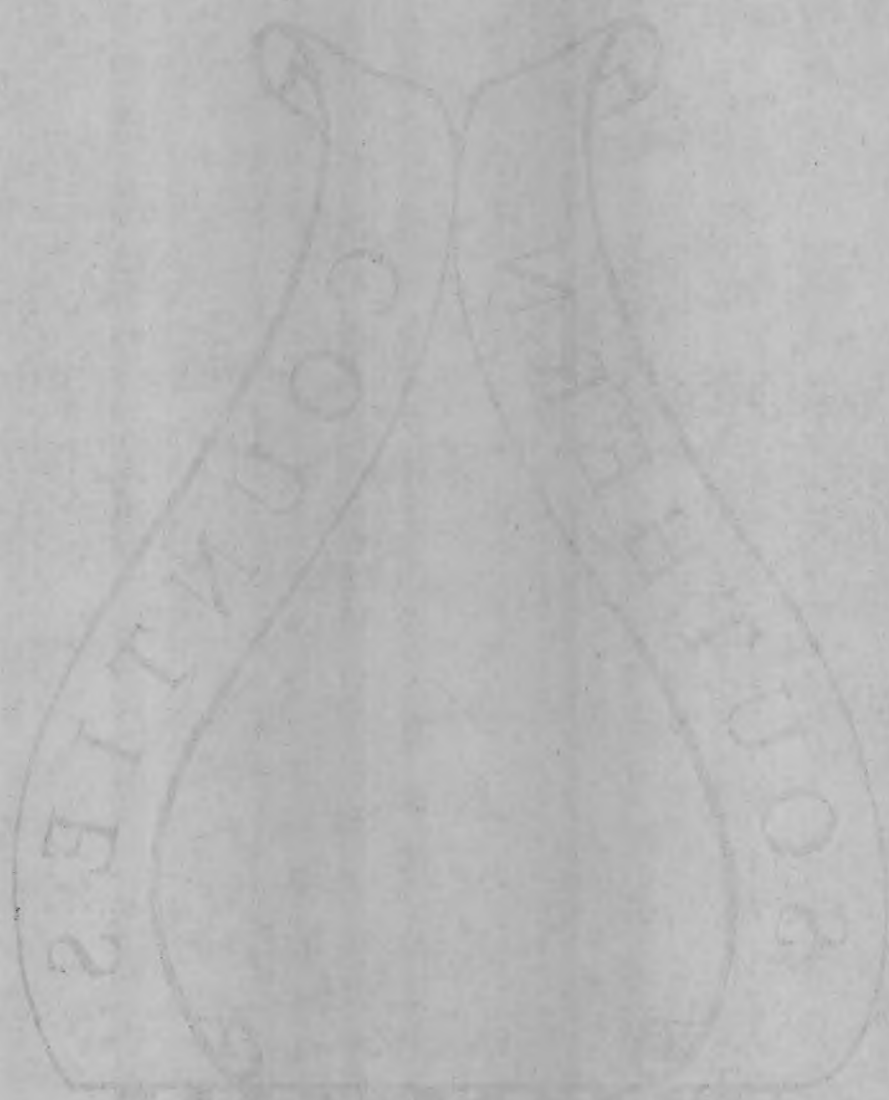

EDITORIAL

Congratulations... to CM Cooley (Essex) on winning the Southern Counties Individual Championship; to JP Levitt (SCCU Under 16 Champion); to PE Johnstone (Middx) (SCCU Under 14 Champion); to JM Emms (Norfolk) (SCCU Under 12 Champion); to D Wood (Kent) (SCCU Under 10 Champion); to Sabrena Needham (Middx) (SCCU Girls Under 10 Champion); to MA Pagden (Cambridge Univ) (SCCU Under 21 Champion); to RJ Jacobs (Kent) (SCCU Under 18 Champion); to Teresa Needham (Middx) (SCCU Girls Under 14 Champion). Also to Middlesex who won the SCCU Counties Championship and went on to beat Gloucestershire in the quarter finals - the best of luck in the final stages! (No firm news of Kent's fortunes yet: we understand that their quarter final match depends on adjudications.)

No congratulations to Middlesex II on defaulting 16 boards in two recent away matches.

NOTICE

Will all those entitled to attend please note that the Annual General Meeting of the SCCU Council will be held on the 9th June. Counties should receive notice very shortly.

SCCU EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Committee met on Friday 11th May 1979 at St Brides. The main items were:

(1) Rules: The Committee has agreed a draft version of the new General Rules to be submitted to Council. Counties will receive a copy of the draft with the notice of the Council Meeting.

The new draft Tournament Rules still await the Committee's attention but it may still be possible to finalise them in time for next season.

(2) Payment by Event: It was reported in the March issue that Congresses and independent Leagues in the Southern Counties will be charged for grading. The Committee decided that this will apply to all Congresses starting on or after the 1st September 1979. Some administrative details are still to be arranged.

(3) BCF Representatives: The SCCU delegates to the Management Board reported a number of things, of which the most interesting* were:

The BCF has tried to draw up a resolution reflecting a composite view of the four Unions on the payment-for-grading question. No one need be surprised that it has failed.

BCF budgeting is henceforth to be on a cash limit basis, with a proviso that if events fail to take place Directors are not to replace them with totally different ones. (Your Editor thinks he understands what this means, and he is sure that finance-conscious readers will.)

Only £10, out of £500 allocated (no, I haven't slipped a nought) has been spent on publicity.

The BCF Council Meeting held on the 21st April approved contributions of £45 per levy point. It also granted a deed of indemnity in respect of payments for which the BCF Secretary and President may become personally liable as a result of the Greater Manchester affair. (It appears that no further expenditure is expected in this affair for the forthcoming season - whether through the law's delays or some other cause your Editor does not know.)

(4) County Competitions: Cambridgeshire have applied to enter a second team in the Montague-Jones Competition, and the application has been accepted. Oxfordshire, who are due for relegation from the Championship tournament, will be invited to stay up in order to have ten teams in each of the top two divisions.

(5) SCCU Bulletin: The Editor pointed out that the Bulletin was not paying its way. The price will be increased by something like 70p next season. (Sorry!)

(6) The BCF had asked our reaction to a suggestion that the London Chess Association should represent all congresses in dealings with the Management Board. The SCCU will reply that, while it welcomes the BCF's desire to involve congresses in its

affairs, it does not think the LCA can be said to represent congresses other than those affiliated to it.

(7) The Tournament Secretary was asked to make representations to Middlesex about the recent defaults in the Montague-Jones competition.

(8) The Committee agreed to nominate the following candidates for Office at the forthcoming Annual Council Meeting of the Union:

REVIEW

A Selection of Chess Problems by Philipp Klett edited and with a solving commentary by JD Beasley: British Chess Magazine, 9 Market Street, St Leonards on Sea, East Sussex TN38 0DQ. A limited edition available from the publishers at £1.95 post free. Paper covers.

I should apologise for reviewing this myself, because my mind goes blank when you say Zagoruyko. Not that Mr Beasley ever does say Zagoruyko in this little book. Philipp Klett (1833-1910) was, I think, a little too early for that. The 51 problems presented here range from two to five movers (but only three are two movers) and the ones I seriously tried I found hard; but they are in a sense problems for the player in that the puzzle element predominates over the thematic ones which I believe are the thing nowadays. The solving commentary gives hints towards the answers, and each solution takes the form of an interior dialogue such as might go through the experienced solver's mind in approaching the position.

An interesting book, and capable of providing days (weeks? months?) of frustration if you don't weaken and look at the answers.
