EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

The Executive met on Friday 30th November at St Brides. A lot of time was spent on discussion of the draft General Rules in preparation for the Special General Meeting on the 1st February. A revised version of the draft is being circulated to Countime.

The Committee also found time (at last!) to look at the draft Tournament Rules which had been hanging fire for months. Some work still remains to be done on these, but there is every chance that they will be ready for the AGM on the 14th June.

Other points of general interest were:

Shannon Trophy: After shopping around, the Executive has selected a new trophy to replace the old Shannon Trophy. It is a silver-plated rose bowl which with engraving will cost around £200.

Quick-play Finishes: Mr Douglas still has not heard from many Counties on the proposal to allow quick-play finishes instead of adjudications in County matches. (You will remember that the suggestion is to have adjudication as the norm but to let match captains agree on quick-play finishes if they so wish.) Kent have indicated that the new proposals would suit them well.

All Counties are urged to think about this and let Jeff Douglas know their feelings well before the AGM so that changes, if desired, can be made in time for next season. BCET Schools Shields: There have been two nominations for SCCU support, but

consideration of them has been deferred until the next meeting (22nd February).

Payment-for-Grading: Here we go again... Counties should have received official notification of all this by the time this issue appears, but for the benefit of readers who are not County secretaries:

The Executive had, as you know, prepared a payment-by-event scheme which the 1979 AGM threw out because it was not thought to have been sufficiently thought through. The Executive, in accordance with instructions, went back to the drawing board and produced a revised scheme. This involved charging for all grading input, but was not basically different in kind from the original payment-by-event scheme.

As the Executive was on the point of sending its revised scheme to the Counties, news filtered through that the BCF was preparing to consider a payment-by-event scheme 131:2

of its own, involving in the first instance congresses (other than Union, County and Junior ones) and perhaps at some later date independent leagues as well.

The proposals before the BCF are a far cry from the original SCCU ideas. There is no suggestion that individual registration would be dropped. Nor, of course, is there any guarantee that the proposals will be accepted. However, they do seem to go some way in the direction of SCCU thinking and they probably represent the best chance of inter-Union agreement. In view of this, the Executive has decided to shelve its own payment-by-event plans - with the SGM's approval - and await events. If the SGM agrees to this, the only real business on the agenda will be the new General Rules.

SCCU TROPHIES

Jeff Douglas, the Tournament Secretary, is seeking information and history. He has in his possession two SCCU trophies:

(a) The Anness Cup, presented to the Union by Miss L Anness, SCCU President 1959/60. The cup is inscribed "Junior County Championship" and the last winner was Essex in 1967.

(b) A chess board "Presented to Junior players of the SCCU in memory of RM Fleming Esq" - this was presented annually from 1961 to 1968; the last winner was Middlesex. It covers the same period as the Anness Cup, but the winners differ.

It seems fairly clear that one of these trophies belongs with the "Metropolitan" 40-board U18 competition, and the other with a jamboree. But which is what, and who was Mr Fleming?

Finally, Mr Douglas also has in his possession the "Imperial Chess Club Champing ship Trophy". This is a cup presented by Mrs A Rawson in 1918 and last won, in 1956, by J Crane. Who, if anyone, does this trophy now belong to? Any information on the Imperial Chess Club would be welcome.

Will anyone with information to offer please write to Jeff Douglas. His address appears on page 1.

(Editor's note: We understand that the 40-board "Metropolitan" U18 competition is actually open to all Counties in the Union. Is this true? Has anyone got a copy of the competition Rules? Are there any competition Rules? Don't say, "Ask the Junior Organiser." We have, and he doesn't know.)

JUNIOR NEWS

KENT JUNIORS played a 14 board clock simul against GM Kotov in December, scoring +5 (NF Dickenson, JR Richardson, MC Portwood, I Galloway, CG Ward) =2 (DJ Edmonds, NR Calver) -7 (Are Kent Juniors stronger than England Juniors?)

SUSSEX: Last year's schools Under 19 Championship went to William Parker School (Hastings) as also did the Under 14. We do not know who won the Under 16 title.

LLOYDS BANK scholarships for the Hastings Challengers were awarded to the following SCCU juniors: SC Conquest (Sussex), DH Cummings (Sussex), Sheila Jackson (Merseysia and Surrey), DJ King (Kent), AC Kosten (Yorks and Kent), AP Lewis (Essex), HD Mac pherson (Oxon and Cambs), MA Pagden (Hants and Cambs), WN Watson (Middx), SC James (Nales and Berks). Selected players had their entry fees paid, and in some cases grants towards travelling expenses. A condition of the awards is that one-third of any cash prize won goes to the London Chess Club to support future BCF Junior Squad events.

The BCF acknowledges significant contributions towards these scholarships from the Slater Foundation and the Aaronson Foundation.

ON GRADING

<u>Quote</u> from Mark Vigor writing in the Editorial column of Tempo for December: ... This County has not the best reputation for the accuracy of its gradings... In the last two years however the number of events in Cambridgeshire has been considerably increased and should provide a more than ample basis for accurate gradings. New events in 1978/79 included the East Anglian Counties Competition, the Cambridge Congress, and the Club Knockout.

But what do we find? Very few of the players I have spoken to feel the new SCCU list bears any relationship to their 1978/79 results... Moreover a number of the most active players still remain ungraded.

Somewhere, it seems, things are going wrong. Are results being properly reported by our organisers? If so, are they being accepted by the SCCU graders? Is the SCCU computer reliable?...

And a message from Trevor Jones, the SCCU Grading Programmer:

A program is now available to produce all itemised grading input for one or more specified players at once. This is (roughly speaking) split up by Counties, Leagues, Congresses and a few oddities (but some things get combined, e.g. Mid Kent League is included under Kent generally).

Cost (payable to SCCU): £6 for a single private run for yourself and any friends etc. or fellow club members; or £1.25 if you are prepared to wait (up to 1 month) until there are enough others to be worth running the job (and then all included on the same list). Each "item" of information gives abbreviated name of event, number of games and number of grading points (plus some data that is of use primarily to graders).

In due course it is intended to be able to produce "Master List" details for any given specified collection of players for (probably) about £10. This would give published (or "firm" unpublished) grade, plus season's total of games and points for a player (however few games), possibly also last year's total, junior's age.

All enquiries (SAE please) to HT Jones - address on page 1.

(Editor's comment: There you are then, all you disgruntled Cambridgeshire players, now you can find out exactly which of your results were included. If you discover that some of them weren't, it might take a bit longer to find out why... Incidentally, I have always understood that computers were by and large reliable, doing what they're told with a sort of pedestrian efficiency. Whether this one's being told the right things is another matter. But then I'm not an expert.)

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE EDITOR

Twelve months ago to the day as I type this, I moved house. Most correspondents have noticed this. Quite often, though, I get match results which have been sent to my old address and redirected by the Post Office. And since we have some space left, some problems for Controllers:

(1) This one happened in a Kent league match recently. One player's clock ran wildly fast, and the defect was not spotted until he was (or appeared to be) in time trouble. The clock was then replaced, and he was given the correct amount of extra time. After the game (which he lost) he claimed that his play had been affected by the supposed time trouble and asked that the game should be re-played.

The Kent Committee still has to rule on this. It seems fairly clear what the ruling must be: by playing on, the player accepted the situation and the result must stand. But what would you have ruled if he had refused to play on?

(2) From a junior match: a player castled long, incorrectly - placing the K on NI and the R on Bl. He moved the K first. I ruled that he must castle (long) legally, which was what he wanted to do anyway. But would there have been a case for ruling simply that he must make (any) K move? The point is not quite as insignificant as it seems, because as it happened castling correctly allowed a mate in one, which the original incorrect castling would not have done!

The next two have not happened to me yet, but I live in fear that they may do. (3) A player has advanced a pawn to the 8th rank, removed it from the board and placed a Queen on the promotion square. He has not yet let go of the Queen. Does he still have the right to promote to a piece other than a Queen?

(4) A player has advanced a pawn to the 8th rank and informed his opponent that it is a Queen. He has not removed it from the board, nor stopped his clock. Does he still have the right to make a piece other than a Queen? And would it make any difference if he had stopped his clock?

All that was supposed to go in the gap at the bottom of page 13 - I do get carried away. Still, since we've started we may as well carry on: I noticed (another!) anomaly in the Laws the other day. You can claim a draw by repetition either if the same position has just occurred for the third time and it's your move, or if having the move you are able to bring about the third repetition and declare your intention of doing so. But the situation is different with the 50-move rule: you can claim only if the 50th move has already happened (Article 12.4). You cannot say "I intend to play such-and-such a move, and claim a draw on the ground that both sidec will then have played..." I cannot see any reason for this anomaly. Can you?
