SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

A Special General Meeting of the Council was held on Friday 25th January 1980. There were two items on the agenda:

Grading: Payment by Event

The Council accepted quite readily the Executive Committee's proposal to shelve SCCU payment-by-event plans in view of the rather similar plans being mooted at BCF Management Board level.

SCCU General Rules

Council also accepted, with half a dozen amendments, the new draft Rules prepared by the Executive. The new Rules took immediate effect. They have now been duplicated ready for issue to Counties before the AGM.

Your Editor ruefully admits that, having carefully reminded everyone about it in the last issue, he forgot to go to this meeting. (Rather unfortunate as he is supposed to be minute secretary.) He owes this account of the meeting to others who remembered.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

The Executive met on Friday 22nd February at St Brides. The main points of general interest were:

Berks/Middlesex dispute

Middlesex wished to change the date of the Championship match against Berks, and

Berks objected that it was now too late for them to agree to this without considerable inconvenience. The Tournament Secretary had already ruled that Middx had given sufficient notice (in November) for changing the date from the 23rd February, and had asked the Counties to play the match on the 22nd March. Berks had appealed to the Executive through their match captain, NW Dennis (SCCU Fixture Secretary!).

Mr Foley-Comer, Middx I match captain, had been invited to attend the meeting to put his County's case. He said that his reason for wanting a change was a clash with the City of London Congress, which would make it impossible to raise a reasonable team. Middx would be prepared to provide an alternative venue in March, at their own expense; also to make all the arrangements.

After considering many factors - including some not mentioned here, in the interests of brevity - the Executive came to the conclusion that there had been regrettable lapses of communication and that neither side could be held completely blameless. It confirmed the Tournament Secretary's decision to cancel the date originally agreed, and asked him to stipulate a date in March after consultation with the two sides. If either side failed to provide a team on the stipulated date, the other side would win by default.

The whole problem was made more difficult, incidentally, by a BCF requirement that first and second places in the Championship tournament should be known by the end of March.

Tournament Rules

The new draft version of the Tournament Rules is now ready and there seems no reason why it should not be put to the Counties in time for next season.

Quick-play finishes in County matches

Mr Douglas had now heard the views of more than half the Counties on his suggestion to allow quick-play finishes by agreement between match captains. The balance of opinion was marginally in favour of the status quo. It had been pointed out that quick-play finishes would require the presence of a controller. Mr Douglas now felt inclined to drop his suggestion.

Travelling expenses of Executive members for committee meetings

It was agreed that members should henceforth be allowed to claim their second class rail fare, minus £2; rather than minus £1 as hitherto. (Your Editor would like to point out that a lot of Committee members have not been in the habit of claiming expenses anyway.)

Grading of fixed-time games

Mr Jones (Grading Programmer) pointed out an anomaly in the BCF rules. Games played at normal rates with a quick-play finish can be graded (for the technically minded, the requirement is at least 15 minutes each QP after a 40-move session, or 10 minutes QP after a 48-move session). On the other hand, games played to a fixed time (e.g. all your moves in 2 hours) are not gradable. There seems to be no real distinction between fixed-time games and games with a QP finish, and Mr Jones would have liked to see the anomaly rectified. The meeting voted narrowly against proposing a change.

(Mr Jones's suggestion, basically, was that any game should be gradable, irrespective of the method of finish, provided each side had at least one hour. Somebody mentioned that even five-minute games show results pretty much in line with grading expectations. Anyone want to propose grading of five-minute tournaments? But we digress.)

BCET Schools Shield

The Committee decided its nomination for a British Chess Educational Trust Shield in 1980. As last year, we would rather not divulge the name of the school until nominations have been considered by the BCET.

Match default

The Committee approved a claim for expenses made by Middx against Kent following Kent's default in the Shannon tournament earlier in the season.

It has not been our practice to name those present at Executive Meetings. On reflection, we don't see why it shouldn't be. This meeting was attended by EE Croker (President; Middx), AB Bamford (Sussex), NW Dennis (Fixture Secretary; Berks), AJ Douglas (Tournament Secretary; Kent), BA Fewell (Herts), RJ Haddrell (Bulletin Editor; Kent), HT Jones (Grading Programmer; Kent), D Mayers (Suffolk), RJ Richmond (Treasurer; Cambs), NG Thomas (Norfolk), and JC Waldron (Oxon). Apologies from HF Bitton (Secretary; Kent), JJ Lauder (Surrey), RCA Lee-Pentecost (Kent), and BG Locke (Grading Secretary; Sussex).

LETTER

Dear Mr Haddrell,

In the January Bulletin Norfolk commented* on the cost and lack of interest in liability insurance. Herts experience is the exact opposite and I am letting you

know of this in case you wish to publish in a future Bulletin.

I investigated both Liability and All-Risks (i.e. loss, theft etc) insurance. The Liability insurance covers negligence by Herts Chess Assn or one of its members. It covers all County events (i.e. matches, Congresses etc) and club events (i.e. club evenings, and any special events) and all club members (even if not actually registered as County members) and all visitors. The present cost is £16, being the minimum premium allowed. With 19 clubs, and 15 or 16 home County matches, Senior and Junior Congresses, this was considered reasonable; and the 1979 AGM voted in favour by a considerable majority.

The normal cost of All-Risks insurance is 1% of amount insured, but subject to a minimum of £15 (this seems a fairly common amount at present). We arranged a group insurance for member clubs - each club pays the County and I send a combined cost to the Company. Of our 19 clubs 5 are works clubs and are covered by their general works insurance. 9 out of the remaining 14 have joined and a tenth has now asked to join. Present amount insured costs £40, which would cost between 2 and 3 times that if done individually. Previously three or four of the clubs were uninsured because of the high cost of a minimum premium!

Our experience is thus a resounding success and just the opposite of Norfolk's.

I should be willing to discuss our experience (and show the exploratory letters from the Insurance Company which I received before effecting the policies) to any County Secretary or Treasurer who is interested.

NEW LAWS

Please read on - this is not another Haddrell polemic. There is available from the BCF, assuming they haven't run out of copies, a list of FIDE Interpretations and amendments to the Laws made since 1975. Your rule book is out of date if you haven't inserted the appropriate marginalia.

Most of the amendments are pretty trifling, but there is one at least which ought to be generally known. It doesn't seem to have been specifically mentioned in Newsflash, so we'll quote it in full:

New Article 18.2, replacing the old 18.2

"If a player claims a draw under the provisions of Article 12.3* the arbiter must first stop the clock while the claim is being investigated. If the claim is found to be incorrect, the arbiter shall then add five minutes to the claimant's time. If this means that the claimant has overstepped the time limit, his game will be declared lost. Otherwise the game will be continued."

* i.e. by repetition

Must say that's a big improvement on the old rule, in spite of the ambiguity of "adding five minutes to the claimant's time". Back to the sloppy drafting again... (All those who don't know what the old rule was anyway, go to the bottom of the class.)

No (written) response so far to the problems for Controllers at the back of the last issue. One BCF Judge has told me that three of the four are "easy", though he omitted to tell me the answers. He is hereby challenged to do so.

Lloyds Bank British Chess Problem Solving Competition

Twelve finalists competed for the £50 prize, plus the Lloyds Bank Trophy, on the 12th January in London. Their task was to solve 8 problems in two sessions of 75 minutes each. The winner was Graham Lee (Palmers Green) who solved them with no errors in 64 minutes. 2nd David Friedgood (Bexley) no errors, 80 minutes; 3rd CCL Sells (Farnborough) 107 minutes, one point dropped.

The competition has proved so popular that plans are going ahead for a similar event in 1980.

QUOTE from the report on the Grading Feasibility Study conducted by the Director of National Grading:

"If finances are linked (in any form) with grading, a majority agreed that this should be in the form of non-publication of grades for non-contributing players, though a significant minority felt that it should be in the form of non-inclusion of results played within non-contributing bodies."
