EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive met on Friday 17th January and Friday 7th March 1985 at St Brides. 13 and 16 attended. (Two Executive Meetings for the price of one. The sub goes up next time.)

(1) <u>Grading</u>. The Grading Secretary reported that the London and Middx Leagues had agreed to pay £25 each towards the cost of the supplementary grading list. (It was largely through late results fron these leagues that the supplementary list became necessary.) The supplementary list was ready to go to the BCF computer. It emerged at the second meeting that the WECU had met unexpected difficulties transferring their data electronically, but had buckled down and done it by hand. The NCCU, for unspecified reasons, had been slow (data still not received 7.3.86). It was hoped to have the Master List ready about mid March, a good bit later than planned.

The Executive looked briefly, and not very productively, at the BCF contract

for graders using computers.

(2) County matches. The Controller said things had gone fairly smoothly so far (though Oxon had sent no results to him). There were no unresolved disputes. A certain team had fielded the same ineligible player twice, despite being duly penalised the first time. (They were duly penalised the second time, too.) Kent's appeal in the matter of RW O'Brien's eligibility (see last issue, page 5) was upheld by the appeals committee on the 28th January. There had been 46 adjudications to mid January, and one (successful) appeal.

The rules sub-committee, which is the same as the appeals sub-committee, has been working on proposed changes to the tournament rules. They are mostly a

tidying-up exercise, and the Executive is still at work on them.

The late-season inter-county KO (U180) has entries from all Counties except Cambs and Surrey.

The unoffical "National Third Teams Championship" looks like going ahead. This, if you remember, is a match between our Champion and the MCCU one.

(3) <u>BCF matters</u>. The Legal 3 General sponsorship for the National Club Championship will not be renewed. Expected deficit is huge; whether on the National Club Championship itself or on the whole range of National Club events put together, your Editor does not know. Both, most likely.

The BCF will seek an increase in the County levy from £95 to £110 per point.

The juxtaposition of these two items is accidental.

The Greater Manchester Affair has been settled out of court! Sanity prevailed at the last minute, apparently. The Bulletin is vague but gathers that some sort of referendum is to be held in the area in question (and don't ask us which area that means). Costs to the BCF have been minimal.

The Executive considered an SCCU paper on grass roots publicity for the BCF. You will excuse us a detailed report: the Bulletin has never been able to work up much

enthusiasm for grass roots publicity.

One County had asked the SCCU to press for the restoration of travel grants in BCF-stage County matches. The Executive felt that such things would be better done on a Union basis, to escape the VAT trap. It was suggested that board fees could esefully be replaced by entry fees.

(4) <u>Junior matters</u>. Two financial items: Someone remarked, apropos of something or other, that the Union never seems to get any budget or accounts from the organisers of the Lloyds Bank/SCCU Junior Championships, although we do contribute money to it. It was agreed this should be rectified. And the recent training event at Highbury had run up a deficit of £111 (122% over budget!). The Treasurer thought this was acceptable. The BCF would like the Union to run two of these training events per year.

There were still (7.3.86) no nominations from the Counties for BCET Schools Awards. There is time to put in a late nomination, but make it quickish. (Write to Peter Morrish). There were no nominations in the SCCU last year, and may well be none again. This is not necessarily a bad thing. BCET Awards are for outstanding achievement over a reasonable period of time, and nominations should not be made lightly. As someone remarked, schools chess has been badly hit anyway by the protracted teachers' dispute.

(5) Executive Committee. Suggestions were made for streamlining and/or democratising the Executive Committee. The perceived problems are that (a) the Executive is too big to function efficiently if everyone entitled to attend does so; and (b) the Counties have no official delegates.

The Executive comprises all Officers, plus up to ten other members elected at the AGM, plus up to three co-opted members. In addition the (only) Life Vice President has always been invited to attend, though he has never done so since he relinquished his other office. Since the number of Officers is not limited by the Constitution, neither is the size of the Executive Committee. At the moment it has 22 nembers. Attendances are usually around 15, which has never (to your Editor) seemed unacceptable. 22 would.

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After consulting the Counties and getting (we think) one reply, the Executive resolved to propose new rules replacing the up-to-ten extra members by County delegates, with each County having the right to nominate one representative for each meeting. (The Bulletin suggested this in 1978. What the Bulletin thinks today...) It was also resolved to propose a steering committee consisting of the President, Secretary, Treasurer, Junior Organiser, County Match Controller, and one other. These proposals may be made at the 1986 AGM if there is time to prepare draft rules.

We may, incidentally, have found a Publicity Officer. An approach has been

made to the Executive by a possible candidate for the job.

Dear Mr Haddrell,

In your various comments on FIDE and SCCU rules I cannot recall your having raised the

question of chess equipment.

In an away county match yesterday the majority of the boards were of the cheap roll-up variety. Unfortunately they had not been rolled up very expertly with the result that playing surfaces were more like the Rocky Mountains than a chessboard. Pieces placed on certain squares stood at crazy angles; on the board next to me one player's third rank had been creased to form a half-inch high battlement to add to his defences.

In my view provision of equipment in this condition is an insult to visiting players and ought to be stopped.

We have also received a letter from Bryan Fewell arising out of the review last time of the chess computer "Excellence". Mr Fewell bought an "Excellence" about the same time and it broke down within a few days. To summarise his letter: He decided to ask for his money back. The refund on his credit card transaction took such a long time that he incurred interest charges of £3-odd, and Competence were not very quick to refund this plus the postage charges incurred. We understand that the matter has now been resolved. (Our own "Excellence", which we kept, is still working.)

LLOYDS BANK sponsorship will be £34,000 in 1986 (its eleventh year). The Problem Solving Championship for 1985-6, which attracted 3221 entries, was concluded in London on the 1st February. The thirteen qualifiers for the Final had ten problems to solve in 2½ hours. ...As a point of interest, is there any precedent or principle governing defaults in junior matches? I always assumed that it was customary to default the bottom boards if there was a shortage of players, subject to the obvious need to leave gaps for latecomers and include reserves if possible. I refer to the Essex v Surrey junior match (at which I was not present) and leave you to draw your own conclusions.
