OXFORDSHIRE-SUSSEX DISPUTESTATEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE RULES AND APPEALS SUB-COMMITTEE

1. The Rules and Appeals Sub-Committee have now considered the dispute arising from the game between Mr M Rose (Oxfordshire) and Mr SJ Newman (Sussex) on Board 3 of the match played on 13th November 1993.
2. The Sub-Committee comprises Messrs NW Dennis, RCN Lee-Anderson, D Metcalfe, JA Philpott and DR Sedgwick. Mr Metcalfe took no part in the decision owing to the involvement of his county.
3. The following points appeared to be common ground:
  - (a) During the quickplay finish, Mr Rose's flag fell;
  - (b) The flag fall was drawn to the attention of the players by Mr MD Nicholas, a member of the Sussex team.
4. Mr FC Manning, the tournament controller, awarded the game to Sussex. Mr JN Stayt, the Oxfordshire captain, appealed against the decision. We received written submissions from Mr Stayt and from Mr P Watson, the Sussex captain.
5. We sought advice on the matter from Mr D Welch, the BCF Chief Arbiter, and from Mr S Reuben, a BCF Senior Arbiter and the BCF Director of Home Chess. Both were very helpful and we would like to thank them for their assistance.
6. We were satisfied that there was no malicious intention or deliberate malpractice on the part of either of the counties or any of the individuals concerned.
7. We were advised that the BCF had not made any ruling, whether by way of precedent or otherwise, that affected our discretion to resolve the matter as we saw fit.
8. We were advised, and we agreed, that Mr Nicholas should not have acted as he did. The BCF Quickplay Finish Rules are clear and unequivocal: "Spectators must never interfere." Mr Nicholas contravened this.
9. We were advised by Mr Welch, and we agreed, that we should not overturn the result of the game in the absence of a complaint from the player concerned. Since it appeared to us on the evidence before us that no protest had been made by Mr Rose himself, we confirmed the result of the game as Rose 0 1 Newman.
10. We were further advised that we could nevertheless, if we considered it appropriate, impose a penalty on Sussex in respect of the irregularity committed by Mr Nicholas. We could, for example, have deducted one game point from the Sussex score, as had been suggested by Mr Stayt. This would have resulted in the match being drawn 9½-9½.
11. We resolved to issue a warning to Sussex. We decided by a majority not to impose any penalty.
12. Accordingly we confirmed the result of the match as Oxfordshire 9½-10½ Sussex.
13. We took note of criticisms made by both Mr Welch and Mr Reuben in respect of the nature and the quality of the evidence received. Both were concerned about the delay in dealing with the matter. Mr Welch considered that statements should have been made by the two players and Mr Reuben considered that a diagram of the final position should have been supplied.
14. We intend to hold a meeting at a later date to consider these points and other wider issues arising from the case.

SCCU EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive met on Friday 25th March 1994 at the Friends House near Euston Station. The attendance of 16 did not include your Editor, who was humping congress furniture around at the time, and this report comes from someone else's notes.

(1) British Championship Qualifying Places. The SCCU had approached the BCF about the possibility of a third BCQ place for SCCU congresses, in view of the Union's size. The BCF were reluctant but might make an extra award to a congress direct. Southend had applied for one but found they were too late; Surrey, hearing about this, didn't bother.

(2) SCCU Auditor. We now have one; his name and address are inside the front cover.

(3) BCF matters (much edited down). Alan Martin, BCF President, is willing in principle to address Union meetings and it is proposed to invite him to the SCCU Council Meeting on the 25th June. [Bad idea. Meetings are for doing business. - Ed]

DR Sedgwick said he felt that BCF Presidents Awards should not be restricted to people who had made a national impact; he personally intended to endorse (his word) two nominations for people whom he did not name.

(4) Haverstock School. Hope we've got this right. Until this season we had been paying something like £35 a "session". The school's new Bursar informed the Union, Septemberish we suppose, that the fee would in future be more like £100. BH Birchall, who had an event imminent, persuaded him to come down to something much more like the original £35. At least that was the Union's impression; there was, however, nothing in writing. It also seems to have been the Union's impression that the orally negotiated fee would apply to all this season's events. Haverstock School don't seem to agree, and we've just been dunned for a season's-worth of lettings at somewhere in the region of £100 a session. The Executive agreed to try and negotiate a compromise. We understand that the Union has removed its equipment from the school.

(5) BCET School Shields. The Executive confirmed its nomination of two schools; we won't name them at this stage.

(6) SCCU County matches. It was agreed that entries for the Open should continue to be required by the current May deadline; in the other competitions the deadline will be in August.

Through an unfortunate oversight the county match captains were not informed, at the start of the season, about the new tie-break rules introduced at last year's SCCU Council Meeting. (The change was covered in the Bulletin at the time, but who reads the Bulletin?) DR Sedgwick, noticing the omission, sent out an explanatory letter late in the season but it is accepted that the situation was not satisfactory. The Minute Secretary has now agreed to keep the rules on disc so they can be updated promptly and sent out every season.

There is a potential Surrey complaint about the regular Middx top board in the U competition. The player concerned, and you can identify him easily enough, is ungraded. We guess that any complaint, at this late stage, would have to be rather informal.

The mooted SCCU U100 jamboree has received "qualified support" from Berks, Essex, Kent and Middx. It is hoped to go for 12 boards on the 12th May.

The U180 KO has attracted entries from everyone except Essex and Middx, and Essex are thought to be mulling it over.

(7) SCCU Nominations for the BCF-Stage county matches were decided. A bit provisionally in one case, since the last match of the season, due to be played next day, had a bearing. We won't list the nominees; complete league tables appear on page 10. The Union has nominated the top two counties in each section, except that Cambs have declined nomination in the Minor Counties so Surrey get in.

(8) Any Other Business, and we think something else, got crowded out.

SCCU Bulletin received to-day (can I be the only one who hyphenates that word?). Always a pleasure to see what nit-picking I can do!

(1) National Club Open round 1: Kings Head  $3\frac{1}{2}$   $2\frac{1}{2}$  Hastings & St Leonards. Hastings top board 194, Kings Head 210+ on top four boards and an IM on 4. Board 2 went to an appeal arbiter: no arbiter being present, the H & SL player stopped clocks per QPF rules and claimed KH player could not win by normal means. Appeal arbiter decided against H & SL, using the "benefit of the doubt" clause in the QPF rules. Had it been a draw, H & SL would have won on board count. Your view? Position (KH White, Black to play) was: 5b2/16/1P3p2/2K2k2/16/B7.

The Bulletin prefers to ask the readers.

(2) Noticed at random: U150 crosstable. The Essex v Sussex match has slipped a column. [Ed: Essex v Surrey actually and it slipped a line, but thanks. I hadn't noticed.]

(3) U150: Essex v Kent, Herts v Middx only 15 boards, so why not a  $\frac{1}{2}$  point each added (per your footnote)? [Ed: Because that's not what Council said. Even with 16 boards in the Open you're supposed to tell the controller first, presumably to prove it was a genuine prior arrangement and not just ad-hocery.]

(4) A Sussex player to whom I extend anonymity has expressed dissatisfaction at a Shannon match being stopped for tea - major break in concentration. Strictly speaking a tea-clock-stop is outside the Laws. Bulletin's views? [Ed: Same as the anonymous player's.]

(5) Wanstead (215:12) is in the "chess county" of Essex. It is in the informal non-statutory county of Essex. It is not within the area covered by Essex County Council...

(6) Hastings & St Leonards Club: 11 new members, just under 20% increase.

I expect you know that Barbican defeated Invicta Knights [in the 4NCL, first leg]. Barring Internationals it must have been one of the strongest team matches in this country, the only comparable event I can think of now is the circa 1988 London v Rest of the Country match - US GM Fedorowicz played! In club chess only the Barbican v Kings Head and Barbican v Wood Green of a couple of years ago get close (each 6 x 220). The recent Hampstead v Kings Head was very one-sided. The upshot of this match is that the Barbican and Maidstone are the two top clubs in the country. Average grade over 7 boards: Barbican 225, Maidstone 226. Including the ladies on board 8, 220 and 222 respectively. Maidstone's average over 6 boards was 231, higher than their board 1!!

Concerning the Oxford-Sussex dispute. The Laws of Chess are crystal-clear. 12.2 states "the flag is considered to have fallen when the arbiter observes the fact. In cases where no arbiter is present, the flag is considered to have fallen when a claim is made to that effect by a player." 15.1 states "the players are forbidden to have recourse to the advice or opinion of a third party, whether solicited or not." The BCF Quickplay Finish Rules state "Spectators must never interfere." The Sussex observer clearly infringed the rule and it is up to the Appeal Committee what action, if any, they should take against the Sussex player and/or team. I cannot remember the Seaford v Brighton match in the early 1980s, where a similar incident is said to have occurred. It is said I ruled the flag fall stood. If this was so, I cannot believe the circumstances were identical. I was probably of the opinion that the person whose flag fell had capitulated before arguing. [Ed: - I didn't name either SWR or the clubs last time, but theirs were the names I'd been given.]

You state that, in your opinion, since the rule about spectators is unenforceable, anybody should be permitted to point out flag-fall. Logically then, murder should be permitted. We cannot prevent its happening! Consider this: a spectator is viewing a game in progress between a friend of his and an enemy. His friend's flag falls. He says nothing. Now the opponent's flag also goes down. He still keeps quiet. At the point where his friend is about to resign, he announces the twin flag-fall. Your suggestion encourages dishonourable behaviour. The current rules simply result in a very occasional disaster brought about by ignorance. If you truly believe it is satisfactory for a player to be given advice during the game by anybody, I find it amazing. 15.1 and 16.5 cover the problem of advice perfectly adequately, given the presumption that players are generally honourable. The Laws have not been written to prevent any possibility of irregular play or to cover all possibilities. This is deliberate, as explained in the Preface (which I amended).

The reason there are usually two time checks in chess is nannyism. Some players are totally unable to control their clocks. Thus, if a game was played at the rate of all the moves in 2 hours, some would find themselves with 5 minutes left after only 20 moves. 40 moves in 100 minutes, followed by all the moves in 20 minutes, prevents this particular absurdity. Against my advice the WECU tried one time control only when they first started quickplay finishes. After one year they switched to two. This preference is partly caused by this being what people are used to. When I introduced quickplay finishes in the 1970s, I tried to make the game as much like adjudication as possible, in order to get the new-fangled things accepted. Thus the origin of the "not trying or unable to win by normal means" rule.

I believe the Laws of Chess, Quickplay Finish, Rapidplay and 5 minute rules should all be as similar as possible. To that end I now believe even the arbiter should not step in to announce a time forfeit. That should be left to the two players. Such changes will have to await 1996 when the Laws will next be considered. Your, or any reader's, chance for immortality.

Your comments in the January Bulletin on Paul Buswell's open letter posed the question as to the tie-break principle used in the "Football League". In my youth there was an organisation of that name which used goal average; nowadays you can choose between the FA Carling Premiership (goal difference) and the Endsleigh Insurance League (goals scored). This very diversity suggests that chess is not the only sport where the most appropriate method of breaking ties is far from self-evident. Indeed, I can remember a number of seasons when Essex County Cricket Club has lost the Sunday League (or whatever it is called now) on tie-break rules which seemed to change annually.

In the context of the SCCU competitions, the 1993 Council meeting voted to change the first tie-break principle from aggregate game points to the result(s) between the teams tying. The debate was of particular interest to the delegate from Essex since a few weeks earlier our County's General Purposes Committee had considered a proposal (defeated in the event) to change the first tie-break principle for the Essex League from the result(s) between the tying teams to aggregate game points! Every method has its advantages and disadvantages, and while I have some sympathy for the point that Paul is making, there must be a whole series of further alternatives that could be legitimately be tried; for example, the number of games won in the course of a season or the fewest number of defaults conceded. Ultimately, a team enters a competition in the full knowledge of the rules that apply, and must accept the outcome of the competition based on those rules. It is right and proper that those rules are periodically re-examined, but excessive tinkering is best avoided, and I would be loath to see the SCCU tie-break principle amended again until we have a few seasons' experience as to how the rule adopted in 1993 is working out in practice.

#### GRADING ODDMENTS

An SCCU player in the Hastings events, whom we will call Puck, came 1st or 1st= in one tournament then played in another, mostly pissing and spending 10 minutes per game at the board, finishing nowhere. There is some suggestion that he wasn't trying very hard in the second event. Martin Cath, SCCU Grading Secretary, has decided that his games in the second event will not be graded. Not for him, that is; they will still be graded from his opponents' end. This is Martin's response to grade-rigging and we have his permission to say so. The SCCU Executive (25.3.94) noted his action. The BCF's response, described in issue 213, has still not been officially announced and may even have been copped out of. It's time they came out of the cupboard.

Puck himself, who is not thought to throw games for his club, has told us about a player from another Union who habitually does just that, paying off his team mates so they won't finger him. One of them must have.

Graders please note: James E Vigus 103863B has been officially recalculated as 184. This is not in the BCF Master List but it is kosher and we've seen a BCF print-out saying so, though it didn't bother to give a date. We have no doubt the BCF will confirm. They didn't tell Martin Cath, though. Only reason we know is, Vigus's dad told us (and we told Martin Cath).

Revised grades seem to be a problem. We noted a number of them last time, and it was not always clear who was being told. Congress organisers or match captains, or the players themselves, may be misled. All but one of the changes had found their way into the graders' Master List, so graders usually won't be. When the BCF doesn't tell the graders, even via the Master List, revised grades become almost meaningless.

#### CHILTERN LEAGUE

INSURANCE CHESS CLUB, as part of their centenary celebrations, visited Amsterdam in November. They beat Delta Lloyd  $10\frac{1}{2}$ - $4\frac{1}{2}$  on the 6th and ING Bank  $8\frac{1}{2}$ - $6\frac{1}{2}$  on the 7th. QPFs, it appears, don't start in Amsterdam until one of the flags falls. In another centenary event an ICC team lost 2-4 to a team of computers.

### JUNIOR NEWS

The revived Metropolitan matches never really got off the ground: Kent and Essex did not take part, and there is some feeling that the competition should be thrown open to all SCCU counties. We reported an U18 match between Surrey and Middx in the November issue, and here's round 2. Names are as given by Middx except we've censored the girls' first names. We're a bit confused about the next bit, but Wil Ransome (Surrey) provided the Middx first names and not the Surrey ones. "Unfortunately juniors tend not to have full initials." We couldn't really print first names for one side only.

After all that typing we haven't the energy for the U11 Girls Second Teams, but Surrey beat Middlesex  $15\frac{1}{2}-2\frac{1}{2}$  over 6 boards (3-round Scheveningen).

We see that both Surrey and Middx are keen for the BCF to run a national counties' U11 team event. The existing national U11 team event, run by the English Primary Schools Chess Association, is open more or less to any team that feels like entering, whether county-based or not. This makes it hard to enter a meaningful Surrey or Middx team in view of the independent entries from South London, Wey Valley, Barnet and Richmond. Shouldn't think EPSCA would just roll over, so presumably we're talking about an additional competition. The switch to county-based teams at 11+ has long been a peculiar feature of English chess. (Many EPSCA teams are in fact from counties, but we're not sure how many of them are run by the adult Associations.)

A controller in the National Club - not the one whose laments we quoted last time - had to send out revised pairings recently after discovering that a result in the previous round wasn't quite what he thought it was. Only the home team, apparently the winners, had sent a result sheet. In fact they'd lost, but this was disguised by the fact that they'd written their names, and results, on the right-hand side under their opponents' club name. Which way round the real winners' score sheet would have been, had they chosen to send one, we can't say. The Bulletin carps at match captains who won't get things right, but you're better than some. The true horror stories come in the Kent Schools League, where you get result cards with ten players' names on but not the least indication of what schools they're from or which age group it is. With seventy-something schools and four age groups, this is irritating.
