Under 18 Minor	Players' grades, both standard-play and rapid-play must be less than 1700. Open to players born on or after 1 September 2003.	£50	£60
Under 14 Open	Grading un-restricted. Open to players born on or after 1 September 2007.	£50	£60
Under 14 Minor	Players' grades, both standard-play and rapid-play must be less than 1550. Open to players born on or after 1 September 2007.	£50	£60

Counties may enter no more than two teams per section and no more than four teams in total, unless otherwise agreed by the organisers. Players must have been aged under 14 or under 18, respectively, on 1st September 2021. The September 2022 Grading List will be used for purposes of eligibility.

RESERVES

There is no official provision for reserves in this event. However, if teams choose to bring reserves, some provision will be made for matches between the reserve players. There will be space available in the playing area for such matches.

ECF GRADING

All games, including reserve games, will be sent for ECF standard-play grading.

TIME CONTROL

All games will be played to the time control of 50 minutes per player per game plus 10 seconds added per move from the start of the game.

TIMETABLE

- Submission of team lists by 18:00 Saturday 24th September by preference
- Arrival from 09:15
- Latest permissible submission of team lists by 10:15
- Round 1 10:45 – 12:45 (assuming 60 moves)
- Round 2 13:00 – 15:00 (assuming 60 moves)
- Round 3 15:15 – 17:15 (assuming 60 moves)
- Prize-giving 17:30

RUNNING LATE

If the tournament is running late, it will not be possible to shorten time controls, as they are already the fastest permissible standard play time controls. The breaks between rounds could potentially be shortened from fifteen minutes to ten minutes. In exceptional cases, where a few games have finished very late, the players of those games will be permitted time to recover and will be allowed to start their next round games late, with a delay of up to 10 minutes.

As there is little scope for catching up should the tournament run behind schedule, it is imperative that it starts on time. We therefore would like to emphasise the importance of teams submitting team lists and arriving on time.

APPLICABLE RULES

The competition rules can be found in the attached "SCCU U14/U18 Jamboree Rules 2020".

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to teams placed first and second in each section. SCCU non-members will not be eligible for SCCU titles. The winners of the U18 Open will be entitled to hold the perpetual trophy for one year and should arrange for it to be engraved and returned in time for next year's event. The highest placed SCCU team in each section will be awarded the title of SCCU Champion.

ECF MEMBERSHIP

VENUE, TRANSPORT & ACCOMMODATION

Orleans Park School, Richmond Road, TWICKENHAM. TW1 3BB. On-site parking is available for about 80 cars. Twickenham Station is 10 minutes' walk from the venue, St. Margaret's Station is 15 minutes away, whilst Richmond Station is a short bus journey away from the venue. A number of buses stop right outside (the stop is called "Orleans Park School"), and a great number stop in Twickenham town centre, close by. REFRESHMENTS

Catering will be provided in the cafeteria on the ground floor of the Attenborough Building by "The Regal Cafe", a sandwich shop and café close to Twickenham Station.
