

VENUE, MATCH AND TRAVEL INFORMATION FOR CHALKHILL COMMUNITY CENTRE

Address: Chalkhill Community Centre, 113 Chalkhill Road, Wembley HA9 9FX

Upon entering the building turn right and the playing hall is straight ahead through the wooden door with 'Main Hall' above it. We will be using either the Aston Hall or Vernon Hall. The use of which one will be confirmed to you.




Start time: 2 pm

Time Control: All moves in two hours and 10 seconds added per move from move one.

Travel:

Tube:

The Jubilee and Metropolitan lines go to Wembley Park station and then it's an approximately five-minute walk to the venue. Take a sharp left after passing through the barriers and turn left out of the station into Bridge Road. Do not go down the steps towards Wembley Stadium. There is a set of traffic lights in Bridge Road, opposite the station exit, which is the best place to cross. Once you have crossed the road turn left and walk along Bridge Road for approximately 120 meters, turn right into Chalkhill Road and continue walking for approximately 150 meters. The venue is on the left-hand side. It is a six-story grey concrete and glass building. It is also called The Welford Centre.




Train:

The Bakerloo line and London Overground (from Euston station) go to Wembley Central station and then it's either an approximately 40-minute walk or the 182, 223 and 297 buses to Wembley Park Station bus stop.

There are trains from Marylebone station to Wembley Stadium station and then an approximately 20-minute walk or the 83, 182, 223 and 297 buses to Wembley Park Station bus stop.


Bus map:



Car:

There is no onsite parking at the venue.

There is free on street parking available further along Chalkhill Road, in Rook Close and Wellspring Crescent, as well as some other adjoining roads. During Wembley event days many of these streets are for local permit holders only. Chalkhill Road is double yellow lines only. Please ensure you read signs carefully, as closer to the Chalkhill Community Centre Pay and Display operates *Please see map below*.

The venue is:

Outside the Congestion Charge zone. **Outside** the ULEZ charge zone.

Inside the LEZ charge zone.

Refreshments:

There are plenty of eating establishments close to the venue, mostly in Bridge Road, as well as many places to eat and drink nearer to Wembley Stadium.

The Community Centre Cafe will be open until about 4pm, so meals and sandwiches will be available to purchase.
